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Message 1

NEW LIFE IN CHRIST

What is the "New Life" we are talking about? It is giving your life to Christ and accepting Him as your personal Lord and Savior.

2 Corinthians 5:17: *"Therefore if anyone is in Christ Jesus, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here."*

There are some people who interpret this section of the Bible to mean that the moment they give their life to Christ, the idols in their father's house have automatically passed away.

They think that when they give their life to Christ, their evil foundation, covenants, or generational curses have passed away, or that they are no longer possessed by demons because those things have all "passed away."

My dear brethren, what the Bible is talking about is that the "old things" refer to your sinful nature. The sinful nature has passed away. The mistakes you made in the past have passed away—but not the generational curses or foundational issues.

The "New Creation" speaks to your spirit man. Your spirit is instantly regenerated, disconnected from Adam's sin, and reconnected to God. However, your mind, your physical lineage, and your earthly circumstances do not get "born again" instantly; they must be renewed.

Think of it like a new driver taking over an old car. The driver (your spirit) is brand new and perfect, but the car (your life's foundation/history) might still have dents and mechanical issues from the previous owner (the devil). The new driver must now drive that car into the repair shop of the Holy Spirit to fix those old issues.

Your family problems did not automatically pass away; what passed away is your sin. Jesus forgives your sin and gives you a new life, so you are now living a new life in Christ Jesus.

Therefore, whoever is in Christ Jesus is a new creation; you cannot become a new creation if you have not given your life to Jesus.

How, then, do you get rid of those foundational issues, curses, or problems in your life and family? It happens after you have given your life to Christ. Once you become a new creation, you gain the right to speak to those mountains. You can say, "Oh ye mountain, be removed," because you have given your life to Him who is able to remove every mountain and set you free. To those who believe in Him, He has given the power to become children of God (John 1:12-13).

When you become a child of God, He gives you the power to rebuke the devil. The Bible says, submit yourself to God, rebuke the devil, and he shall flee from you (James 4:7).

Many Christians try to use the second part of this verse ("Resist the devil") without obeying the first part ("Submit yourselves to God"). Spiritual warfare operates on a chain of command. You cannot rebel against God by living in sin and expect the devil to obey your command.

The authority to make the devil flee does not come from your voice or your volume; it comes from your submission to God. When you are fully submitted to God, you wear His authority like a badge. When the devil sees that badge, he doesn't run from you—he runs from the God standing behind you.

However, if you are still living in sin, there is no way you can rebuke your father, the devil. You belong to the devil if you live in sin (John 8:44). In the spiritual realm, there is no such thing as an orphan. You are either a child of God or a child of the devil. Paternity dictates inheritance. If the devil is your father, you inherit his curses and his destruction.

If God is your Father, you inherit His peace and power. You can only become an enemy to the devil if you leave him and let Jesus become your Father. That is when the mountain will leave; that is when the foundational issues will go away in the name of Jesus, by faith, fasting, and prayer through righteousness and God's mercy.

When these problems leave, it does not mean they stop existing in history; it simply means they stop disturbing you. You will no longer be affected because you are covered by the blood of Jesus Christ.

Righteousness is a shield (Proverbs 13:6), and God protects the righteous, not just the most prayerful (Psalm 37:39-40). We often treat prayer as an offensive weapon, but we forget that righteousness is our defensive armor. When you live righteously, you give the enemy no legal landing strip to park his problems in your life.

Jesus Christ said, *"Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest."* If you do not come, you will not receive rest. You can only receive rest when you come to Him.

Therefore, coming to Him is the first thing. You become a new creature first, and then you have the privilege to pray and ask for whatever you want in His name, and it will be granted unto you.

Giving your life to Christ is the first step: it is redeeming your soul from destruction. That is when you start the real work, for salvation comes before absolute deliverance. The Bible says in Philippians 2:12 to *"work out your salvation."*

When Paul says to "work out" your salvation, he is using language similar to mining for gold. The gold is there (your salvation), but you must dig it out to see the value.

In the context of deliverance, this means the potential for total freedom is deposited in you when you accept Christ, but the manifestation of that freedom requires your participation. Now that you have been saved, redeemed, and received, you must work toward your salvation and deliverance in every single area of your life, the same way you work at your daily job.

New life in Christ means letting go of the sinful life. Jesus washes away the sinful nature, makes you clean, makes you righteous, and makes you presentable unto His Father. He gives you the right to become a child of God. Then, you have the right to rebuke the devil and the power to pray.

When you pray, He answers you because you are in Him, and He is in you: *"If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you"* (John 15:7).

The Bible says in Romans 8 that there is no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.

So, when you are in Christ, you are no longer condemned by your old self. The devil will not have any reason to condemn you, judge you, or deprive you of the things Christ has prepared for you.

Becoming a child of God is the first step to overcoming your foundational issues, marital issues, evil covenants, and other struggles. God is ready to take that problem and that pain. However, you must be patient with the process. You may have been in the world for a long time, and just as you gradually went deeper into sin, your deliverance from the problems accumulated during that time is often a journey.

Do not always expect a "quick miracle" the moment you give your life to Christ. Every sin carries its own consequences, creating both physical and spiritual complications. But rest assured, God will deliver you from them all as you continue in righteousness.

While some demons may leave instantly at the mention of His name, others are stubborn. As Jesus taught, there are some obstacles that require a higher level of prayer, fasting, and consecrated living to be fully uprooted. As you persist in your devotion, He will clear all the "bushes" in your life and on your path.

Personal Prayer

Lord Jesus, today I surrender my life fully to You. I accept You as my personal Lord and Savior, and I believe that You died on the cross at Calvary to set me free from all sin. Thank You, Lord, for giving me a new life, making me a new creation, and washing away my sinful nature.

I ask for the power to work out my salvation, the wisdom to walk in Your ways, and the spiritual authority to uproot every stronghold, foundational issue, and evil tradition in my lineage. Grant me the grace to live a righteous, holy life that honors You.

Father, remove every obstacle, clear every bush and mountain from my path, and give me the rest You promised. I stand today in the victory of Jesus Christ, confident that You are my refuge, my strength, and my deliverer.

In Jesus' mighty name, Amen.

Message 2

JESUS IS GOD

Today, I am going to explain this topic in a way that ensures you truly understand, because if I were to ask you now, you might explain it in different ways. Muslims often say that Jesus is not God. So, today we will understand what God is and who God is.

The Definition of God

According to the Oxford Dictionary, God means the Creator and Ruler of the universe, the source of all moral authority, and a Supreme Being. It also defines God as a superhuman being or Spirit worshiped as having power over nature or human fortunes—essentially, a deity.

Therefore, going by this definition, if God is a Supreme Being, then Jesus is God. Jesus is not a normal human being; He is a Supreme Being.

Why Jesus is God:

He has Authority: In Matthew 28:18, Jesus said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me." Since He holds the source of moral authority, He is God.

He was in the Beginning: John 1:1-3 tells us that Jesus was in the beginning, and all things were created through Him. Jesus told the people, "Before Abraham was, I am." He was present during creation. The scripture says, "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God." Jesus is the Word; therefore, He is God. Don't forget that Prophets of the Old Testament prophesied about His coming: Isaiah 7:14, Micah 5:2, Isaiah 9:6. Even the Muslim Qur'an states that "*Jesus is Allah's word which he cast into Mary, and a 'spirit' from him*" (Sura 4:171). Muslims, wake up from slumber and embrace Jesus for he alone is the savior.

He has Power over Nature: Jesus casts out demons, heals the sick, and performs miracles. He has power over nature and human fortunes.

His miracles include Turning water into wine (John 2:1-11), healing the nobleman's son (John 4:46-54), healing the paralytic at Bethesda (John 5:1-15), feeding the 5,000 (John 6:5-14), walking on water (Matthew 14:22-33), healing the man born blind (John 9:1-7), raising Lazarus from the dead (John 11:1-44).

Spiritual and Human Analogies

To understand this spiritually, we acknowledge the Trinity: God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. They share one Spirit and one purpose. It is like marriage; the Bible says a man shall leave his father and mother and cling to his wife, and they become one. You share everything, even the same name. Let us bring this down to human philosophy so you can understand it better.

The "Small god" Concept: Do you know that you are a god? You are a "small god." We use terms like "Godfather"—why call him that if there is no "god" in it? We call a landlord "Lord" because he owns the compound. Jesus quoted from Psalm 82:6 in John 10:34, "Ye are gods." You are a creator in your own right; if you did not have a father, you would not exist. Your father created you because he is a small god. Humans are worshiped in a sense—people greet you, honor you, and thank you. If you are a god by being created in God's image, then Jesus, who is the Supreme God the Son, is certainly God.

Idols: We also have idols, shrines, and deities (Juju) which are considered gods. In Exodus 20:3, God says, "You shall have no other gods beside me," acknowledging that other "gods" exist in the minds of men.

Biblical Insights

We have looked at the dictionary and human philosophy; now let us look at the Biblical insights.

Jesus is Lord: "Lord" means owner. God says in the Old Testament, "I am the Lord your God," meaning He is your Owner and Creator. While you can create something without owning it, God owns us. Exodus 20:2 says, "I am the Lord your God who brought you out of the land of Egypt." In the New Testament (John 13:13), Jesus says, "*You call me 'Teacher' and 'Lord,' and rightly so, for that is what I am.*" Since God is the only one worthy of worship, and Jesus is Lord, Jesus is God.

Jesus is the Savior: Only God can save. In Isaiah 43:11, God says, "I am the Lord, and apart from me there is no savior." Yet, in the New Testament (John 4:42), the people confirmed, "We know that this man really is the Savior of the world." If only God can save, and Jesus is the Savior, then Jesus is God.

Jesus is the Messiah and Son of God: Messiah means the "Anointed One" or "Chosen One." In Matthew 16:15-17, when Jesus asked Peter who He was, Peter replied, "You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God." Jesus confirmed this was a revelation from the Father. Furthermore, in John 5:23, Jesus explains that whoever does not honor the Son does not honor the Father. With this, Jesus is God.

Jesus is the Way, the Truth, and the Life: In John 14:6, Jesus says, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." This means before, we prayed to God directly and offered sacrifices of bulls and rams for the forgiveness of sins, but now, Jesus shed His blood and became the Mediator. God no longer hears you if you don't accept His Son Jesus Christ because it is only the blood of Jesus that can cleanse your sins.

Jesus and the Father are One: In John 10:30, Jesus declares, "I and the Father are one." Consider an analogy: If a wealthy father named Patrick puts his son, Juwon Patrick, in charge of his company, the son has full authority. If you go to the company asking for the owner, the son can say, "I am in charge." Even if you see the father, he will direct you to the son because he has given the son all authority. If you need money, the son gives it. When you thank the son, the son gives glory to the father. This is how Jesus operates. When you pray in the name of Jesus, God answers.

Jesus is "I AM": In Exodus 3:14, God told Moses, "I AM WHO I AM." In John 8:24, Jesus repeats the same thing, warning, "You will die in your sins if you do not believe that I Am [who I Am]."

Jesus is the Word of God: As mentioned, John 1 confirms the Word was God, and the Word became flesh. Jesus is the gospel of truth and salvation.

Jesus has Ultimate Authority: In Matthew 28:18, Jesus confirms all authority in heaven and earth is His. No human or angel has this; only God does.

Jesus Rose from the Dead: Only God can defeat death. Other religions may claim Jesus was just a messenger or that He didn't die, but that is like reading a

biography of a president written 6,000 years before your birth and claiming he was never president. It doesn't make sense. Muhammad came much later and wrote about Jesus, but Jesus existed before him. We see humans worshiping fellow humans, like the man called "Olumba" in Calabar, who is worshiped despite being a regular human. If people can worship men and idols, surely, we must worship the One who resurrected. Even some scientists claim God does not exist after reaching the sky or visiting the moon, but they cannot reach the foundation of the earth or get to the end of the universe. Don't be deceived.

Jesus Confirms He is God: In John 10:34-36, when accused of blasphemy, Jesus argued: If the law calls humans "gods" (to whom the word of God came), how much more appropriate is it for the One whom the Father set apart and sent into the world to call Himself the Son of God? He is not just a "small god" like us; He is the One sent from God.

Understanding the Divine Plan

God created you in His image to have dominion, just as He has dominion. You are a god to your children or your household. In the same way, Jesus is the Supreme God over us. When Satan tempted Jesus in Matthew 4:7, asking Him to throw Himself down, Jesus replied, "Do not put the Lord your God to the test." Jesus affirmed He is the Lord God. Satan did not understand God's plan for the crucifixion and resurrection. He thought killing Jesus would end it, but it only fulfilled the plan.

Answering Critics

I watched a debate where a Muslim cleric challenged a Christian to show him where Jesus said, "I am God." It takes the Holy Spirit to understand the scriptures. Even some Islamic scholars admit that Jesus is coming back to judge the world—a role reserved for God. If you are a human and scripture calls you a "god," how much more is He who came from Heaven?

Personal Prayer: "Father, I thank You for the revelation of who Jesus is. I ask that You grant me the spirit of wisdom and understanding, that I may fully grasp the depth of Your divinity. Lord, help me to not just read the Word, but to know the Word. Silence every doubt in my heart and give me the boldness to declare Your sovereignty to the world. In Jesus' name, I pray. Amen."

Message 3

THE MYSTERY OF SALVATION

Salvation is the process of being saved, but it is not a singular event. Salvation is like a manual vehicle: the more you engage the gears, the more you speed up. Let me shock you: no Christian is Forever or fully saved yet. The doctrine of "once saved, forever saved" is a deception. Satan uses his agents—false teachers and prophets—to deceive you into believing that salvation cannot be lost or that 'once saved is forever saved,' simply to make you continue in sin. You must not forget what the Bible explicitly says in 1 John 3:8: *'He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose, the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil.'* If you are still committing sin, you are not of God, regardless of what any preacher tells you.

If you continue to sin under the guise of grace, you are mocking God. 'Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.' (Galatians 6:7). Jesus Himself warned us in Matthew 24:4: "Take heed that no man deceive you.'

Salvation is a practice you must continue forever. As long as you are alive, you are not fully saved; you are "pre-saved" or in the process of salvation. Anyone who tells you that once you are saved, you are saved forever is deceiving you, and that deception will mislead many people to hell.

The mystery of salvation is more complex than a chemical reaction; you need the revelation of the Word. Some pastors may want you to go to hell because they too are going there. However, if a pastor is truly from God and preaches the true Word, he will tell you the truth. You have your Bible with you—do not let anyone deceive you. Say "no" to them. If you allow yourself to be deceived, it is your own business; on the last day, God will not have mercy on you simply because you were deceived. You are responsible.

Salvation requires your full attention. If you do not pay attention to salvation, Satan will buy your attention.

Salvation is like an educational institution with different levels: Primary School > Secondary School > University.

You cannot jump the process; you must work hard, read, study, and practice to pass each level to graduate. You cannot claim to be a graduate when it is not yet time for your graduation.

Being 'fully saved' means you have achieved eternal life; it means you have been raptured and entered heaven. To reach this graduation, you must diligently follow the three simple steps of salvation."

Step 1: Believe and Accept Jesus

You will be saved from the power of Satan: If you believe in and accept Jesus, you will be saved from the power of Satan. Before salvation, the enemy blinds people to the truth. *"In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them."* (2 Corinthians 4:4)

Believing means you reject Satan and accept Jesus as your Lord. When you do this, God transfers you from darkness to light. *"Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son."* (Colossians 1:13)

You will be saved from perishing: When you give your life to Him, He saves you from perishing, removes your name from the book of death and write it in the book of Life. *"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life."* (John 3:16)

You will receive the power to be a child of God: Being saved at this level does not mean you have received eternal life yet; it means you are saved from Satan's power, saved from perishing, and given the power to become a child of God. *"But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name."* (John 1:12). How do you do this? Through confession. *"That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved."* (Romans 10:9)

It is now time for you to start making use of this right. Simply receiving Christ does not make you a mature Christian or fully qualified; you must take the next step. You will never make heaven if you do not enter the second step. Many are fake Christians because they stay here in Step 1. You are close to a boom, but you must move forward to eternity—from Level One to Level Two—until you graduate.

Step 2: Obey God's Word and Be Baptized

When you obey God's Word, put off your earthly nature, and are baptized, you enter the second level. Here is where your sins are washed away and you truly become a new creature.

You will be saved from the power of sin: The power of Satan is different from the power of sin. When you are a sinner, you are a slave. *"Jesus answered them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, whosoever committeth sin is the servant of sin."* (John 8:34)

But when you obey God's Word, you are saved from the power of sin. Satan can no longer compel you to commit sin, and your desire for sin will go away because grace now empowers you. *"For sin shall not have dominion over you: for ye are not under the law, but under grace."* (Romans 6:14)

Be Baptized and become a new creature: We have all sinned and come short of the glory of God; we were all born in sin. When you enter this second level of salvation, you are washed by the blood of Christ and baptized by the Holy Spirit. *"Therefore, if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new."* (2 Corinthians 5:17)

What has passed away? Fornication, stealing, and all sins have passed away. Women dressing half-naked has passed away. Men dressing carelessly or smoking has passed away. Other sins that must pass away include adultery, lying, fighting, drunkenness, idolatry, witchcraft, ungodliness, malice, envy, and pride etc. It is sin that must pass away because you are in Christ Jesus. If you do not let these things pass away, they will draw you back. *"He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned."* (Mark 16:16)

Baptism is the second level. In the Kingdom of God, His will is done, and there are blessings for the people. Do not be baptized before obeying; otherwise, it will be hard for you to obey. That is why some churches take you through teachings before baptism—to ensure you know what you are going into. Baptism is like initiation into the Kingdom of God.

Step 3: Continue in Holiness and Endure to the End

The third level is to continue in holiness and righteousness, working out your salvation to the end.

"...work out your own salvation with fear and trembling. For it is God which worketh in you both to will and to do of his good pleasure." (Philippians 2:12-13)

You will be fully saved from the second death and Receive Eternal Life: You are not fully saved until you endure to the end of your life, that is when "forever saved" comes in. Salvation is not completed at confession, nor sealed by Baptism. Anyone who claims to be "forever saved" while still alive is deceived. Full salvation is proven only at the end—when a man dies in righteousness.

Until that moment, salvation must be worked out with fear and trembling. There are no shortcuts, no guarantees without endurance, and no crowns without warfare. *"But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved."* (Matthew 24:13)

Eternal life is not promised to beginners, but to finishers. It is granted only to those who remain faithful to the end. The second death is the final test. Those who overcome sin, the world, and the flesh will escape it; those who do not will be destroyed by it—regardless of what they once professed.

"He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; He that overcometh shall not be hurt of the second death." (Revelation 2:11). This is the truth many refuse to preach. Salvation is a lifelong battle, and only those who endure, overcome, and die in righteousness will be fully saved. You must be a conqueror. Ask yourself: What is your level of salvation?

Conclusion

This is your final warning. There will be no excuses on judgment day. God will not ask how popular your church was, how anointed your pastor sounded, or how comfortable your Christianity felt. He will ask whether you obeyed Him.

Many are already condemned—not because they never heard the truth, but because they rejected it. They preferred a gospel that entertained them rather than one that transformed them. They chose comfort over conviction, popularity over purity, and religion over righteousness.

Stop deceiving yourself. Heaven is not cheap. Grace is not a license to sin. Mercy is not permission to live carelessly. God is patient, but He is not foolish. What you sow, you will reap.

The road to life is narrow, not crowded. Anyone telling you otherwise is a liar, no matter how anointed they appear. Jesus never promised ease—He promised a cross. If your Christianity has no cross, it has no Christ.

You must examine yourself daily. Kill sin or sin will kill you. If you make peace with sin, you have declared war on God. No sinner enters heaven unchanged. No rebel inherits eternal life. Run from Satan or Satan will run your life.

This generation loves miracles but hates repentance. They want blessings without holiness, crowns without endurance, and heaven without obedience. It will not work. God cannot be mocked.

Today, decide whom you will serve. Strip yourself of excuses. Repent deeply. Obey fully. Endure faithfully. Finish strong. Because in the end, only one thing will matter: Will you overcome—or will you be overcome?

“He that overcometh shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son.” (Revelation 21:7). Anything less than full obedience is rebellion. Anything less than endurance is failure. Anything less than holiness will not see the Lord.

Personal Prayer

"Lord Jesus, I come before You today acknowledging that I cannot save myself. I ask for grace to not just start this journey, but to endure to the very end. Open my eyes to the truth of Your Word and deliver me from every deception of the enemy. I choose to lay down every weight of sin, every earthly nature, and every disobedience that tries to hold me back. Empower me to work out my salvation with fear and trembling, so that on the last day, I will not be found wanting but fully saved in Your eternal Kingdom. Amen."

Message 4

BETWEEN LAW & GRACE

The Law is defined as a set of rules and regulations established to regulate behavior. Every institution, whether a home, school, marketplace, or country, operates under laws. Without them, there is no order. Just as nations have constitutions and villages have local rules, God gave the Law to the children of Israel in Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, and Deuteronomy.

These laws remain active today. Even when Jesus came, He did not abolish the law; rather, He came to fulfill it. Many claim they are no longer under the law but under grace, yet they misunderstand the terms. If you truly understood grace, you would not sin, for grace is not a license to function within sin.

The law was created with strict penalties to identify those who truly love God. Under the law, sin brings instant punishment. Just as civil laws sentence offenders to jail regardless of their status, God's law demands justice. If you commit a sin intentionally, the penalty is death. If unintentional, the law demands atonement, such as a sacrificial ram. The law acts as a strict guardian; violating it brings judgment without mercy.

However, Jesus came to remove the judgment and punishment from the law by introducing Grace.

Defining Grace

To understand this, we must define Grace. Grace is a collective term for God's generosity to mankind. Grace encompasses salvation, redemption, mercy, forgiveness, blessings, favor, anointing, and power. However, possessing material blessings does not equal having God's grace if one lives in sin. God is Holy, and to operate under His grace, you must live a righteous life. You cannot continue to sin that grace may abound (Romans 6:1).

The 11 Differences Between Law and Grace:

Consequence of Sin: The Law says "sin and die" or be punished. Grace says "confess, stop sinning, and be forgiven." Jesus took our punishment on the cross so that the law of death will no longer apply to us if we confess and forsake our sins.

Sacrifice: The Law requires a blood sacrifice (animals) for atonement. Grace requires only confession and true repentance. Jesus paid the ultimate sacrifice, so we no longer kill animals for the forgiveness of sins.

Scope of Forgiveness: Forgiveness under the Law is primarily for unintentional sins and acts only after punishment or sacrifice depending on the gravity. Forgiveness under Grace covers both intentional and unintentional sins, provided there is genuine repentance.

Requirement: The Law requires only obedience to the rules. Grace requires both faith and obedience.

Type of Justice: The Law brings instant judgment (similar to "jungle justice"—an eye for an eye). Grace brings justice tempered with compassion. Jesus demonstrated this when He saved the woman caught in adultery from being stoned (John 8:3–11).

Belief Status: Those who do not believe in Jesus remain under the Law and are vulnerable to the devil's oppression. Those who believe in Jesus are under Grace but must not continue to sin, for "sin shall not have dominion over you" (Romans 6:14).

Flexibility: The Law is constant and rigid; it simply dictates punishment. Grace is dynamic and sovereign. Like a King pardoning a criminal, Grace can override the sentence of the Law because the price has been paid.

Outcome: The Law brings death. Grace gives life to those who believe through Christ Jesus (the Spirit gives life).

Origin: The Law was given through Moses. Grace and Truth came through Jesus Christ (John 1:17).

Role: The Law is a Guardian/Tutor; Grace is a Gift (Galatians 3:24, Ephesians 2:8-9). The law reveals our error, but the grace of salvation is a gift from God, it corrects our error.

Visibility: The Law is written in the Scriptures (visible code). Grace is invisible; it is a spiritual reality you must believe to receive.

Summary and Warning

You must understand that the moral standards of the Law are still active.

Jesus only came to abolish the penalty of death and the system of animal sacrifice by fulfilling them. He took the punishment upon Himself. Therefore, you need faith for the blood of Jesus to work for you, and faith here simply means to believe in Jesus Christ and Obey his commands.

Do not be deceived by those who say the Old Testament laws no longer exist. Jesus warned in Matthew 5:17-19 that He did not come to abolish the Law or the Prophets but to fulfill them. He stated that anyone who sets aside the least of these commandments and teaches others to do so will be called least in the Kingdom of Heaven. The laws regarding morality—such as not bowing to idols, dressing modestly, and maintaining sexual purity—remain valid foundations for a holy life.

The Danger of Abusing Grace

Be very careful, if anyone continues to sin willfully after giving their life to Christ, believing they are covered by grace, such a person is a liar and belongs to Satan. The Bible is clear on this matter. Paul asks a critical question in Romans 6:1-2: *"What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?"*

Furthermore, the Apostle John exposes the true nature of those who persist in sin in 1 John 3:8-9: *"He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning."*

For Grace to work for you, you must give your life to Christ. And for your faith to be effective, you must stop sinning; otherwise, your "old self" returns and takes over. Do not be deceived by your so-called pastors who preach that you can live however you want; "once saved" is NOT "forever saved." Salvation is a continuous walk. You must actively maintain your standing with God. As the Scripture commands in Philippians 2:12: *"...work out your own salvation with fear and trembling."*

Personal Prayer

"Lord Jesus, I come before You today with a humble heart. I thank You for the gift of Grace that saves me from the judgment of the Law. I ask for Your forgiveness for my sins, both known and unknown. Wash me clean with Your precious blood and sanctify my life. I surrender my will to You; help me to walk in holiness and obedience. In Jesus' mighty name, I pray. Amen."

Message 5

CELEBRITY OF SIN

Almost everyone desires to be a celebrity, seeking fame on platforms like TikTok, Instagram, and Facebook. However, the critical issue lies in your activities and how you achieve that fame. Many glorify Satan through sinful content and secular songs, displaying nakedness and vanity; these individuals are "celebrities of sin" working for the devil, directly or indirectly.

A celebrity is simply someone popular whom people celebrate and talk about – like worldly musicians, actors, social media influencers, etc. But you must ask yourself: are you being celebrated for rubbish, or are you celebrated in Christ for doing good? If the world celebrates you for worldly things, you are a celebrity of sin. It is far better to remain unknown on earth than to be well known and lose your soul in hell.

The Trap of Online Fame

Many people damage their souls and invite demons into their lives by exposing their bodies on apps just to make money. Unfortunately, useless and evil content often garners the most views online. Algorithms often promote nonsense while suppressing good content, forcing people to engage with evil trends.

Specifically, we see a disturbing trend where some of our young girls dance seductively on apps specifically to attract money from men. They perform sensual moves, often half-naked, hoping to get "gifts," money transfers, or attention from older men or strangers online. This is not just harmless fun; it is digital prostitution and high-level immorality. When you use your body as a tool for transactions, you are selling your dignity and opening a doorway for spirits of lust and perversion to enter your life. You are trading your future glory for cheap, temporary cash.

While comedy and laughter are good, we must question the nature of the jokes. It is possible to be a comedian who tells stories and makes people laugh without resorting to rubbish or obscenity.

Corruption in the Entertainment Industry

In the entertainment industry, particularly movies and secular music, unnecessary immorality is rampant. Directors do not need to show actual nakedness, sexual intercourse or smoking to pass a message; such scenes only corrupt the viewers. This corruption explains why many actors and secular musicians live troubled lives and often meet tragic ends. Acting out evil invites evil.

Similarly, secular songs should not be played at weddings or birthdays because they do not glorify God. Even some Christian musicians are beginning to mimic worldly beats and dancing steps, which compromises their message. Secular songs turn a wedding from holy matrimony into unholy matrimony, because you cannot glorify Satan and expect Jesus to bring peace, love, and joy into your family. Whatever a man sows, that he will also reap. If you sow the seed of Satan, you will reap the works of Satan; but if you sow the fruit of God, you will reap the fruits of the Spirit.

True Success vs. Fake Life

We also face the danger of influencers and false prophets. Many influencers are demonically possessed, yet people follow them blindly. False prophets perform arranged miracles and teach human rules rather than salvation. The church is meant to be a place of prayer and the love of God, not a seminar for financial success and immorality.

True success comes only from God. Success is not merely making money; it is fulfilling your purpose and returning safely to your Maker in heaven. If you journey through life and do not make it back to heaven, your life is a failure.

A Warning on Modesty and Envy

To the models and those who desire to show off: exposing your body is a sin. God is not pleased with indecency because indecency is the foundation of sexual immorality. This includes acts like showing off your breast or part of it, wearing bikinis, see-through clothes, short skirts, skinny clothes, female trousers, sleeveless shirts, and so on.

Do not be deceived by the fake lifestyles you see online; many celebrities borrow cars and live beyond their means just to impress followers, while some are agents of darkness – belonging to one secret society or the other. Do not envy them or their associates, for their lives are often empty and their wealth is not from God.

The Call to Godly Content

If you are a content creator, do not market sin. Create content to promote decency, holiness, prayer, and righteousness. If you consistently post about God, people will eventually connect with your light. Colossians 3:17 commands us: *"And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him."*

Romans 8:6-8 reminds us: *"The mind governed by the flesh is death, but the mind governed by the Spirit is life and peace."* If you are a celebrity of sin, you are in the realm of the flesh and cannot please God. You must be spiritual in all your ways. If you serve the Lord carnally, you are unknowingly serving the devil.

Do not be afraid to be called "too spiritual." When people see you, they should identify you as a child of God. If your friends sin, your presence should make them uncomfortable because light and darkness cannot flow together.

Conclusion

Finally, Galatians 5:16 says, "Walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh." When evil desires rise, rebuke Satan immediately through prayer, song, or the Word. Do not keep quiet; declare God's power. If you stand firm in the Spirit, even the ungodly will come to respect you. Some Christians do not support Gospel Celebrities; they only show their support for worldly celebrities. This is an error and a sin.

Personal Prayer

"Lord Jesus, I come before You today asking for the grace to live a life that truly honors You. I refuse to be a celebrity of sin or to seek the applause of this world at the expense of my soul. Help me to govern my mind by Your Spirit, that I may find life and peace. Grant me the boldness to separate myself from darkness and to use my talents solely for Your glory. Let my life be a successful journey that leads me back to You. Amen."

Message 6

THE FREEDOM FROM SATAN

Do you know that Satan can offer you a kind of freedom? It is true; Satan gives freedom just as Jesus gives freedom, but there is a crucial difference. The freedom from Satan causes destruction and will ultimately end you up in hell. In contrast, the freedom from Jesus leads to eternal life.

The freedom offered by Satan makes you love the things of the world, and this love for the world will drive you to commit sin. You will fornicate, lie, dress indecently, steal, kill, and commit all manner of atrocities. This deceptive freedom makes you commit immoral acts without caring whether they are good or bad, or who is watching you. It makes you hate the things of God, allowing you to wear whatever you want and go wherever you please. However, at the end of the day, this freedom will put you in trouble.

I saw a video of a child trying to plug his hand into an electric socket. The mother screamed, "No!" But the father said, "Leave him, let him be free." The child went ahead to plug his hand in because he was given "freedom," and he was shockingly electrocuted. That freedom led to destruction. Wherever you are given the freedom to do bad things, just know that the end is death and destruction.

The Broad vs. Narrow Road

Consequently, the devil's freedom leads to ruin. The devil gives people the freedom to make wealth, but they kill, steal, and do terrible things to get it. Some have robbed banks and succeeded, only to end up in jail or dead. Some do terrible things to make money and succeed for a while. But you, as a child of God, if you try to take that route, you will not make it because you do not belong to that kingdom.

They have taken the "Broadway." Everyone is taking that road because it looks easy, and the majority want to legalize sin just because "everyone is doing it." You might ask, "Let me do the same; does it mean all these people are going to hellfire?" Yes. That is the freedom Satan gives them. Satan will give you the freedom to sin, but Jesus will give you freedom from sin.

As the scripture says: *"Enter through the narrow gate. For wide is the gate and broad is the road that leads to destruction, and many enter through it. But small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life, and only a few find it."* (Matthew 7:13-14).

The devil welcomes everybody; he says, "Do what you want, just come." That is why hellfire is full—because it is open to the crowd. But when Jesus gives you freedom, He brings you under the law of God so you can make heaven. We must look at things beyond this world; if we only look at the things of the world, we are useless on earth, for it is vanity upon vanity.

Restrictions for Your Safety

The gate to destruction is wide, but the gate to life is not easily accessed. For instance, if you are sick, you seek a means to get better. You cannot eat whatever you want; you might take a little pap and milk until you are well. But if you are instructed by a doctor to avoid certain foods due to a health condition, and you disobey because you want "freedom," you put your life at risk.

The road to destruction is open; you can create new sins and do what you want because the devil wants you to have the knowledge of sin—just like he deceived Eve to eat the forbidden fruit. But in God's Kingdom, there are instructions and laws. You do not behave how you want; you live the way Christ wants. If you live how you want, you are pleasing your flesh, and the works of the flesh are the works of the devil.

The end of the broad road is hellfire. Imagine a road where you know there is a pit at the end. Even if the road is tarred and you are driving a great car, will you take it? People insist on taking the easy road, but the road to heaven is narrow; you may fall and rise, but you keep walking. At the end, it is a palace.

The Trap of Occultism and Wealth

The devil always hides the destruction waiting ahead. When people join certain occult kingdoms disguised as "Friends Clubs," they are not told the truth at the beginning. They will not tell you to bring your mother or your daughter. No. First, they give you money.

You are looking for direction, and they ask for your account number. They transfer 50 million naira. You rejoice. You even pray for them, asking God to bless them, not knowing you are praying for an occult man.

You waste the money or run into trouble, then you go back asking for more. They continue to spoil you. After that, they slowly introduce you to what they call their “Inner Chambers.” When you enter, you see people tying red or white wrappers. You are shocked. They quickly silence you and say it is only a friendly association.

After one year, they demand your mother or another family member for sacrifice. You are shocked because this was never mentioned at the beginning. But by then, you are trapped, and a price must be paid.

The devil never gives anything for free. He takes the bigger share—95%—and leaves you with 5% or even less. But God gives fully. God gives you 100%.

My Personal Testimony

I speak from experience. In 2008, while I was in the village hustling, I was into baking cakes with my friend. We found a magazine that advertised: *“Become Rich Without Ritual.”* I called the number, and a woman answered. She explained that they would give us 10 million naira but asked us to come to Edo State, Nigeria, with two cows and two “Ghana-must-go” bags to carry the money.

We prepared to go. We concluded that since the advert said *“without ritual,”* it was safe. But as God would have it, my mother had a vision. She told me, *“I saw you coming into the house with a calabash full of blood.”*

I was shocked because I do not play with visions, and I do not want to stain my hands with blood. I met my friend and explained the vision to him, but he insisted on going. He said even if a blood sacrifice was involved, he would do it just to make money.

Immediately after that conversation, the woman called me on the phone to know when we were coming for the initiation. I aborted the call. Instantly, my phone screen went blind and the phone spoilt completely. I took this as a sign from God. I went home and cut off contact with my friend since he insisted on going. God saved me from a path of destruction because I listened.

Satan’s Freedom is Bondage

Satan’s freedom is a trap. You want to be free, but you end up in the devil’s law where you cannot leave. The devil closes your eyes and understanding. That is why they say love is blind.

The devil will make you love someone who will destroy you. You see someone you should avoid, but you say, *"I will kill myself for him/her."* Once you are in, that "person" turns to a scorpion and stings you to death. The devil uses what you love most to destroy you, see (Galatians 5:19-21).

You love fornication, masturbation, bad friends, cultism, gossip, indecent dressing, fighting, clubbing, drunkenness, fraud, seduction, idolatry, cheating, adultery, bribery, secular songs and contents, etc.? your reward is dangerous.

The Broadway gives you temporary freedom but eternal suffering. Freedom in Christ means you live according to God's commandment and are free forever. *"So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed."* (John 8:36). But if Satan sets you free, you will be in bondage and a slave forever.

Conclusion

Satan can set you free from righteousness, but that puts you into the bondage of sin and death. If Satan sets you free, you are in bondage. But if Jesus sets you free, you are free physically and spiritually. Those who go to false prophets, spiritualists, and native doctors for healing and miracles are going into a covenant of everlasting bondage. Go for the freedom of Christ, for Satan's freedom is worse than death.

Personal Prayer

"Heavenly Father, I come before You today seeking the true freedom that can only be found in Your Son, Jesus Christ. Lord, open my eyes to see the deception of the enemy and the trap of the 'broad way.' Grant me the grace to enter through the narrow gate, walking in obedience to Your Word. I pray for the strength to overcome every temptation, the wisdom to discern Your truth, and the courage to live a life that pleases You. Deliver me from the bondage of sin and the destruction of the world. Set me free indeed, that I may dwell in Your house forever. In Jesus' mighty name, I pray. Amen."

Message 7

HOW DEMONS POSSESS PEOPLE

The first question we must ask is: What are demons or evil spirits? Whatever is not clean is unclean; whatever is not holy is unholy. As a human being, you cannot be empty. You either possess the Holy Spirit or an evil spirit.

Evil spirits are like military forces Satan uses to enforce or carry out his agenda and policies; they come into people's lives to destroy them. Some spirits may appear to help people make wealth or money, but in the end, they face a terrible penalty. The end is death, sickness, or danger, apart from the ultimate consequence of hell. So, every human is either possessed by the Holy Spirit or an evil spirit.

As the Bible says to believers in 1 Corinthians 6:19: *"What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?"* This means that every true born-again Christian has the Holy Spirit residing in them.

The Biblical Example of Saul

When you look at the Bible, there is a man named Saul whom an evil spirit entered. Saul disobeyed the Lord, and the Lord permitted an evil spirit to torment him (1 Samuel 16:14). Evil spirits have one job: to torment people. Whether in marriages or individuals, demons—such as marine spirits, witchcraft, or Ogbanje—cause people to behave in strange ways. You will know someone has an evil spirit because they do not behave like a child of God. If you have the Holy Spirit, you will behave like a child of God. The Spirit of the Lord reveals the truth, and the fruit of the Holy Spirit shows in your life. However, if you have an evil spirit, you will exhibit sin, deceit, indecency, and filthiness, behaving in abnormal ways that displease the Lord.

The Spiritual Vacuum

You cannot just be empty. Your spirit connects with other spirits. It needs a higher spirit to function. If your spirit connects with an evil spirit, you are with the devil. If your spirit is with the Spirit of God, you can please the Lord.

Without the Holy Spirit, no man can please God because you will not discern right from wrong. You may know something is wrong, yet you still want to do it because the evil spirit is in you.

This is why believers must undergo the baptism of the Holy Ghost to receive power and direction, as Jesus promised in Acts 1:8: *"But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth."*

The Cycle of Deliverance and Sin

Evil spirits are not there to make your life better; they are there to destroy what God has put in you. They cause barrenness, confusion, hinder marriage and prosperity. Many go for deliverance, but if they go back to their old ways, the evil spirits return. Evil spirits take pleasure in sin; once they enter, you find yourself committing a particular sin repeatedly because that is what pleases them and what makes them remain.

Some visit churches for deliverance, but even after the session, the demons return or perhaps never left. Why? It could be because the person went back to sin, or because the pastor or prophet is a false teacher using demonic powers. As Jesus said in Matthew 12:26: *"And if Satan cast out Satan, he is divided against himself; how shall then his kingdom stand?"* A demon cannot genuinely cast out a demon; they only deceive you.

Furthermore, some of you have hundreds of demons inside. Just a few "foot soldiers" might be cast out during prayer, but the "rulers of darkness" and "strongmen" remain. These higher-ranking spirits can only be dislodged when you start living a consistently righteous life. Even the demons that were cast out do not leave you alone immediately. They have already planted a seed of sin in you. They will always visit you, checking to see if the door is open, pushing you to go back to that specific sin so they can reclaim their place.

If they continue checking on you for a long time and realize you have refused to go back to sin, they will finally stay away. Think of it like a toxic relationship: it is hard to leave someone you loved and invested in for years. In the same way, demons do not want to lose you because your body is their temple and their home, which they "rented" by fulfilling your worldly desires. For demons to leave you thoroughly, you need to continue in righteousness.

The Best Deliverance

So, the best deliverance is the deliverance of the soul. If you continue to sin, you remain a child of Satan, and Satan will build his home in your life and send demons to live in it. They enter you by force. They compel you to do evil, either spiritually or physically, knowingly or unknowingly. Under their influence, you have no choice but to carry out the works of Satan. But God will not force you; He has given you a choice.

While living a righteous life, you must fast and pray so that the Holy Spirit will take over and chase away evil spirits. It does not matter where they come from; if you stop obeying them, they will have to leave. But before you stop obeying them, you must take cover in the Lord by giving your life to Christ completely. Otherwise, some stubborn demons will afflict you if you refuse to serve them yet are not serving God. For example, some people who are possessed by demons to become native doctors, spiritualists, Marine or witchcraft agents—especially by inheritance—often die, get sick, or become useless if they refuse to serve these demons without completely surrendering to Christ Jesus.

Check the characters of some of our beautiful girls today; it is nothing to write home about. A woman cannot be virtuous or submissive if she has demons in her. They wait for you to commit sin so they can enter—that is their access point. You do not need to formally invite a demon; if you live a sinful life, you invite them by default. Conversely, the Holy Spirit is invited through a righteous life in Christ Jesus.

How Demons Get Access to People's Lives

Demons do not just enter without a cause; there must be a link or an opening.

Through Sin: Sin is the primary door. If you do not commit sin, a demon cannot enter you. There are demons in charge of every specific sin—fornication, visiting shrines, cultism, occultism, lying, drunkenness, and indecency (wearing bikinis, female trousers, bum shorts, half-naked or skinny clothes for seduction), etc. When you engage in these acts, the corresponding demon enters you.

They will whisper to you, convincing you that "everyone does it" or "God will forgive you," or that "it does not matter." Be careful who you follow. Some people you admire on social media or even some pastors may be agents of darkness using demonic powers. If you follow them, you are going to hell with them. Jesus said in Matthew 12:43-45 that when a demon leaves a person, it wanders; if it finds its old home empty (without the Holy Spirit), it returns with seven more wicked spirits.

Through Birth or Inheritance: Demons can be inherited. Some children are possessed from birth because of their parents' covenants, idolatry, or sinful lifestyles. You may see a child behaving wildly or possessing strange powers; this is often an inherited spirit from the lineage.

Through Your Thoughts: Just as Judas betrayed Jesus because the devil put the thought in his heart, demons gain access through your mind. When you nurse evil thoughts—how to steal, commit adultery, or harm others—you invite demons to inspire you on how to execute those plans. Sometimes they send a fellow human agent to help you execute those plans, and you wonder how the person came to know about it. You may say "they are God-sent," but they are actually demon-sent. When you meet people and your spirits correlate instantly, it is because you serve the same master.

Through Worldly Things or Entertainment: Demons gain access through worldly songs, videos, fashion, and friendships. There is a spirit behind every fashion trend. When you dress indecently or nakedly, you attract spirits of lust. If you dress to expose your body, you are working for the devil by making others stumble. Jesus warned that it is better for a millstone to be hung around your neck than to make a "little one" sin. When you are possessed, shame is removed, and you will boldly do things that please the devil. When you watch porn or worldly videos, you are giving access to demons.

Through Words and Actions: Your tongue can destroy your destiny. Gossip, negative confessions, false reports, and fraud open the door for demons to use you. They are waiting for your actions to align with their desires so they can take over. When you take actions that do not glorify God, demons take interest in you because they realize you will be useful to them.

WHAT DEMONS DO IN PEOPLE'S LIVES ONCE THEY ENTER, THEIR MISSION IS CLEAR (JOHN 10:10)

Enforce Sin: To compel the victim to carry out the works of Satan so they can disobey God and end up in hell.

Steal Blessings: To steal their joy, peace, life, and destiny.

Destruction: To destroy their marriages, businesses, careers, and relationships.

Kill: To kill them prematurely, either spiritually or physically (e.g., dying in cult clashes or robbery, etc.).

Mental Affliction: To make them sick, confused, mad, depressed, or frustrated.

Bondage: To put them in spiritual captivity where they struggle to pray or read the Bible or even end up in jail.

Advertisement of Sin: To use them as tools to advertise sin through worldly music, indecency, evil contents, and bad influence.

Destruction of Others: To use them to destroy other people's lives either spiritually, physically, legally, or financially.

Blindness: To blind their minds so they cannot understand the Gospel or see the light of God (2 Corinthians 4:4).

Shame: To bring public disgrace and shame upon them and their families.

What the Holy Spirit Does in People's Lives Conversely, when you have the Holy Spirit

Comfort and Empower: He comforts the brokenhearted and empowers believers for service.

Produce Fruit: He produces the fruit of the Spirit: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control, etc. (Galatians 5:22–23).

Enable Holiness: He gives you the strength to live a holy life and please God, which you cannot do on your own.

Revelation: He reveals the deep secrets of God to you and gives you direction for your life.

Guidance: He guides you into all truth (John 16:13), preventing you from falling into error or deception.

Intercession: He helps us pray when we do not know what to say, interceding for us with groanings that words cannot express (Romans 8:26).

Boldness: He gives you the boldness to preach the Gospel and stand for the truth without fear.

Seal of Ownership: He marks you as God's property, protecting you from the claims of the devil (Ephesians 1:13).

Conclusion

Whatever does not glorify the Lord glorifies the devil. There is no middle ground. If you are not pleasing God, you are pleasing Satan.

Remember, a house does not stay empty for long. If you cast out a demon but do not fill yourself with the Word of God and the Holy Spirit, the enemy will return. You must be intentional about closing every door—whether it is through your dressing, your actions, your speech, or your associations. Guard your heart with all diligence. Refuse to be a dumping ground for Satan's agents. **If you are possessed by an evil spirit or demons, you will not enter the kingdom of Heaven.** Choose today to be a vessel of honor, filled with the Holy Ghost, useful to the Master and prepared for every good work.

Personal Prayer

"Lord Jesus, I come before You today acknowledging that I cannot walk this path alone. I ask that You fill every void in my spirit with Your Holy Ghost so that no darkness can find a place in me. Guard my heart from evil thoughts, my eyes from worldly distractions, and my feet from the paths of sin. If there is any inherited shadow or open door in my life, I ask for Your cleansing blood to shut it forever. Empower me to live a life that glorifies You, not just in church, but in my secret moments. I surrender my all to You. Amen."

Message 8

HOW YOU WORSHIP IDOLS UNKNOWINGLY

We must first ask, what are idols? They are gods, often golden images molded in human form or in the likeness of things in heaven or on earth. When you worship these things, you may not realize you are worshipping idols, but there are many ways people commit this sin without knowing. Today, by God's special grace, you will identify and avoid these traps.

There are specific forms of idolatry we must recognize:

Idol Worshipping in Shrines: This is the most well-known form. In many communities, you will find shrines and idols. These are "*small gods or deities*" that cannot breathe, see, walk, talk, or answer prayers, yet people visit them. Even if you are not a native doctor, do not keep idols in your family. Simply visiting a shrine or eating food offered to idols makes you an idol worshipper.

According to Revelation 2:14 and 1 Corinthians 10:14-21, you must not eat or drink anything dedicated to an idol during celebrations or rituals. Doing so is a direct act of idolatry.

Idol Worshipping in Homes: Many people, even those who attend church, still maintain idols in their homes and perform sacrifices for them. You must check your home diligently. Since you started following Christ, have you truly discarded these things? If you still keep charms, amulets, or "family deities" hidden in your house while going to church, you are an idol worshipper.

Worshipping Human Beings: Worshipping a human being is synonymous with worshipping an idol. In Acts 10:25-26, when Cornelius fell at Peter's feet to worship him, Peter made him stand up, saying, "I am only a mortal myself."

We must worship God alone, because Scripture commands, "Worship the Lord your God, and serve him only" (Matthew 4:10). The danger of accepting or giving worship to humans is clearly illustrated in the Bible: when Herod received the people's praise as though he were a god, "he did not give praise to God, an angel of the Lord struck him down, and he was eaten by worms and died" (Acts 12:23).

Likewise, Nebuchadnezzar was humbled after exalting himself in pride, later confessing that God alone is supreme, declaring that the Lord is able to humble “those who walk in pride” (Daniel 4:37). Therefore, when a person allows others to worship them, or when worship is directed toward another human being—whether a pastor, a celebrity, or even a spouse—it becomes idolatry, violating God’s command, “You shall have no other gods before me” (Exodus 20:3), for God alone will not share His glory with another.

Self-Worship and Carnality: Colossians 3:5 teaches us to put to death sinful earthly desires, stating clearly that greed is idolatry. When you prioritize your personal life, possessions, or worldly things over the things of God, or praise yourself, you are worshipping idols. Set your mind on heavenly things not earthly things.

Those who try to save their life—making their life an idol—will lose it. We must not love the world or praise ourselves, for we are nobody without God.

Idol Worshipping in Churches: This is a major issue today. Many churches, such as the Catholic Church, keep idols and images. Even if an image is claimed to be God or Jesus, bowing to it is idolatry. God does not live in statues; once a statue is kept, demons possess it. They claim not to worship it, but they bow, kneel, and pray to it; this is idolatry. No person engaging in such acts will enter the Kingdom of Heaven, no matter their status.

Apart from the statue being a sin or idol, demons are also looking for statues to inhabit. This is why sometimes people experience statues of Mary or other images shaking, crying, or making signs. I recall a time in the village when Nollywood actors set up a shrine for a movie. The moment a "chief priest" character invoked a name, thunder struck, and everyone scattered. This proves that demons are waiting to be worshipped.

If you bow to these images in church, thinking it is normative, you are worshipping idols and demons at the same time. At times, these demons or evil spirits may give you miracles full of sorrow, and you believe it was the statue or God who heard you through the statue. Some also say they pray with the statue to connect to God—this is not possible. If we need a statue to pray to God, then faith does not exist. You pray by faith because you cannot see God.

Mary herself is not worshipable because she is a mortal, and Jesus called her "Woman," not "Mother," because He knew her place.

Those who reference these images, sing, dance, clap, bow, or acknowledge them are all idolaters because these are forms of worship to God. Praise, reverence, singing, acknowledgement, obedience, requests, services, kneeling, or even loving are all forms of worship.

Some Catholic priests who run ministries often called Adoration ministries, or similar names, place statues of Mary by riversides or sometimes inside pools or streams, where people are encouraged to pray, bathe, or seek healing and miracles. Such practices redirect worship away from God and introduce a dangerous form of idolatry. Any spiritual devotion tied to water, objects, or images rather than to God Himself opens the door to deception. Scripture is clear that God alone must be worshiped, and no created being—saint, angel, or image—should receive reverence that belongs only to Him. When faced with problems or afflictions, believers must seek God's face genuinely, in righteousness and obedience, rather than trusting in rituals or sacred places.

Exodus 20:4-5 commands us not to make images of anything in heaven, on earth, or in the waters, and not to bow to them. God tolerates no rivals. Whether it is an image of Mary, Abraham, Jesus, Peter, Paul, Moses, or Elijah, you must not create it, pray to it, worship it or ask it to pray for you. Today, some churches even conduct gay weddings and promote lifestyles contrary to God, becoming headquarters for demons.

My Personal Story: Here is a short story: Between the year 2001 and 2003, I lived with my grandmother's sister. They were core Catholics while we are Pentecostals. They hated us as Pentecostals and often called us "Prayer Warriors" or "Bird's Church Worshipers" in mockery. But when calamity hit, many of them left the Catholic Church and joined a Pentecostal church for prayers.

Now, they preach against statues in Catholic churches and often tell us they were blinded by Satan at that time. Only God can do this. You that is reading, may God open your eyes in Jesus' name.

The Futility of Idols: Isaiah 44:9–10 declares, *"All who make idols are nothing, and the things they treasure are worthless... Who shapes a god and casts an idol, which can profit nothing?"*

This passage exposes the emptiness of idol worship and the shame of trusting in what human hands have made. John 4:24 reminds us that God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and in truth, not through images or physical representations. Acts 17:29 further affirms that God's nature is not like gold, silver, or stone shaped by human design and skill.

Therefore, do not be deceived. Anyone bowing to a molded image is risking hellfire. Just because you were born into a church or grew up there doesn't mean you will keep attending it despite all the warnings. You must save your life even if it means cutting off from your family members for a while; eventually, they will realize the truth.

Isaiah 46:5-7 God asks, *"To whom will you compare me?"* Idols are carried on shoulders and cannot save anyone from disaster. You must reject idols completely. It does not matter if you were born into a certain tradition; you must choose the truth. Romans 1:22-23 warns of those who claimed to be wise but became fools, exchanging God's glory for images of humans and animals.

Conclusion

Isaiah 42:8 states, *"I am the Lord: that is my name: and my glory will I not give to another, neither my praise to graven images."* You cannot share God's praise with idols, Mary, or dead saints. Trust in the Lord with all your heart. If your eye or hand causes you to sin, cut it off. As Jesus said in Mark 9:43: *"And if thy hand make you sin, cut it off: it is better for thee to enter into life maimed, than having two hands to go into hell, into the fire that never shall be quenched."*

Reject idols in your home, community and church. Stay far from people who ask you to worship idols. Stand firm in the truth.

Personal Prayer

"Heavenly Father, I come before You today acknowledging that You alone are God. I ask for forgiveness for any way I have unknowingly worshipped idols, whether through images, possessions, or placing humans above You. Lord, open my spiritual eyes to see the truth and give me the boldness to disconnect from every form of idolatry. Cleanse my home, my heart, and my mind. I declare that I will worship You in spirit and in truth. Deliver me from the deception of the enemy and let Your glory alone be seen in my life. In Jesus' mighty name I pray. Amen."

Message 9

WORK OUT YOUR SALVATION

Salvation simply means being saved from sin and God's curse through Christ Jesus. When you hear the phrase "work out your salvation," what comes to your mind? It means putting the Word into practice—practicing the Word of the Lord, not just hearing it.

You must practice the Word. If the Word says do not fornicate, you stop fornicating. If it says do not go naked on the streets, you stop. If it says do not fight or lie, you stop it and put the command into action.

Salvation is not merely given; it is obtained through repentance and believing in Christ Jesus. By faith, you receive salvation. First, you must believe that Jesus died for you and accept Him as your personal Lord and Savior. You need faith to do this because you cannot see Him physically. Even when you did not know He died for you, the Gospel tells you He died on the cross for your sins. It is left to you to say, "Let me believe in the One who died for me and see the wondrous things He will do in my life."

However, once you accept Jesus, the Word must be exhibited in your everyday life. You cannot just go inside, claim you have accepted Jesus, and then continue to do whatever you like; you need to start living a Christ-like life.

The School of the Kingdom

Consider this instance: You go to school and study banking. After graduation, what is next? You look for employment to exhibit your talents and apply what you learned in school. The Kingdom of God is exactly like a school. When you come in, you accept the terms and conditions, and you start obeying the rules and regulations of the Kingdom. If you do not obey these rules, you will be thrown out.

Philippians 2:12 says: *"Wherefore, my beloved, as ye have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling."*

You must work it out with fear and trembling. Do not say, "Nobody sees me, so let me commit this sin." Do not say, "My pastor is not around, or the person who led me to Christ is not here, so let me sin." God sees you. He sees in secret, physically and spiritually. He sees everything you do. Therefore, do not act because people are watching; act because God is watching. He wants you to put His Word into practice and keep His commandments. Working out your salvation leads you to holiness and righteousness.

Escaping Wrath Through Obedience

Matthew 3:7-10 records that when John saw the Pharisees and Sadducees coming to be baptized, he said to them: *"You snakes! Who told you that you could escape the punishment God is about to send? Do those things that will show that you have turned away from your sins."*

He warned them not to rely on claiming Abraham as their ancestor, for God could raise descendants for Abraham from stones. The axe is ready at the root of the trees; every tree not bearing good fruit will be cut down and thrown into the fire. Just as they claimed lineage, people today say, *"Grace covers us; grace abounds."* But John the Baptist asked if they thought they could escape punishment while remaining unchanged.

Romans 6:1 asks: *"What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? God forbid."*

Grace cannot abound if you continue to sin. God expects you to stop sinning. If you make a mistake, ask God for forgiveness, and He will forgive you. But you must not continue in sin. You must do things that show you have turned away from sin. When people see you, they should say, "This man used to do these things, but he does them no longer." James 1:22 warns: *"But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves."*

Going to church every day cannot save you if you do not practice the Word. This message is not just for the world, but for those in the Lord who believe but do not keep His Word. Matthew 5:16 tells us to let our light shine so that people see our good deeds and praise our Father in heaven.

Understanding True Grace

Let us address what grace truly is. If anyone tells you that grace works for you while you willfully sin, it is a lie. If you remain in your sin—committing it twice, thrice, and continuing—God will not forgive you simply because you confess, unless you first turn away from that sin. Repentance means turning away and stopping the act completely.

Grace comprises God's mercy, God's favor, God's blessings, God's help, and God's power and anointing. Matthew 6:33 says, "*Seek ye first the kingdom of God and all his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.*" You cannot access supernatural blessings without keeping the rules of grace. Every other thing you see people enjoying is just general provision—like God feeding the birds. But for supernatural blessings, you must be a doer of the Word.

Conclusion: The Exam of Holiness

Returning to the school analogy: Accepting Jesus is the enrollment. Salvation is the subject. Holiness and righteousness are the assignment. You cannot pass until you submit your assignment to be marked. Your score determines your grade, your grade determines your result, and your result determines your reward.

Just as a school gives you a uniform and sets rules, "Don't wear this," "Don't go out at this time"—the Kingdom has rules. If you do not pass the exam of holiness or keep the kingdom rules, you cannot make heaven. You must thirst for righteousness. Working out your salvation requires action, just as you work daily to earn a living. You must work to earn the reward of salvation.

Personal Prayer

Father, I stand before You today with a humble heart. I ask for the grace to not just be a hearer of Your divine Word, but a doer of it in every aspect of my life. Lord, when the temptation to compromise arises, remind me that You are watching, not to condemn me, but because You desire my holiness. Give me the strength to submit my assignment of righteousness with excellence, that I may pass the test of life and enter into Your joy. Let my life be a mirror of Your light, proving to the world that I have truly been changed by Your love. In Jesus' mighty name, I pray. Amen.

Message 10

JUDGEMENT & CONDEMNATION

When you hear the terms "Judgment" and "Condemnation" in the Bible, they carry specific, distinct meanings. Judgment is the ability to make considered decisions or come to sensible conclusions. On the other hand, Condemnation refers to the action of sentencing someone—especially a sinner—to punishment or eternal damnation.

Put simply: Judgment leads to either condemnation or correction, while condemnation leads to punishment or sentencing.

Types of Judgment and Condemnation

To understand this fully, we must distinguish between the various forms these take in our world and in the Word:

Types of Judgment

Moral Judgment: An assessment of actions or behaviors based on ethical principles and values.

Legal Judgment: Decisions made by a court regarding the outcome of a case.

Personal Judgment: Individual opinions about people, situations, or things.

Biblical (Divine) Judgment: A decision made by God related to sin and holiness.

Types of Condemnation

Legal Condemnation: A formal declaration of guilt resulting in penalties like jail or death.

Moral Condemnation: Strong disapproval of character based on ethical standards.

Biblical Condemnation: The pronouncement of divine judgment sentencing a soul to eternal punishment in hell. Strictly speaking, no human can biblically condemn you; only Jesus is the Judge. Humans can offer correction, reproof, or legal punishment, but they cannot sentence your soul to eternity.

Forms of Biblical Judgment

The Bible presents various ways judgment is handled to maintain order and holiness:

Old Testament Capital Punishment: Sins like blasphemy or idolatry were punishable by death to purge evil from Israel (Leviticus 24:16).

Community Discipline: The New Testament describes excluding members involved in unrepentant sin to maintain church purity (1 Corinthians 5:1-5).

Rebuke and Correction: This involves correcting someone to help them repent. Galatians 6:1 instructs us to restore a person caught in wrongdoing gently.

Eternal Judgment: The final judgment where every individual is judged according to their deeds and faith.

The Purpose of Judgment vs. Condemnation

When I teach the Gospel, I do not judge your soul or condemn you to hell. Rather, I attempt to put you right with God by revealing the consequences of violating His commandments.

Recently, a friend wanted to interview me for his platform. I noticed he had plaited his hair, and I declined. I told him, "Sir, you cannot interview me. If you want to interview me as a representative of my field, you must look like a child of God. Your identity matters." He replied, "You are condemning me." I answered, "I am not condemning you; I am telling you to stop plaiting your hair so you can look decent and reflect the Word of God."

When you correct someone's mistake, they often cry out, "You are judging me!" But if I were condemning you, I would be sentencing you to death. I don't have that right. However, if I don't tell you the consequences of your actions, you will continue in error.

We do not "romance" the Word of God; we speak the truth. God empowers us to judge actions, not to condemn people, but to correct them so they can change. Silence in the face of sin is not love—it is betrayal.

The Bible makes this responsibility clear in Ezekiel 33:8: “When I say to the wicked, ‘O wicked man, you shall surely die,’ and you do not speak to warn the wicked from his way, that wicked man shall die in his iniquity; but his blood I will require at your hand.”

This means that when truth is withheld, both the sinner and the silent watchman are guilty. Therefore, we must speak plainly, warn boldly, and preach the truth without fear. Correction is not hatred; it is obedience. Only the truth can bring repentance, and only repentance can bring life.

Addressing Common Misconceptions

When you try to correct a sinner, they often raise three popular objections:

"You are condemning me." The answer is: I cannot condemn you because I cannot send you to hell. However, you are already condemned by God if you are living in sin.

"He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already..." (John 3:18). To believe in Jesus means to carry your cross and keep His commandments (John 14:15).

"Do not judge, that you may not be judged." They quote Matthew 7:1. Jesus said this regarding hypocritical judgment. He removed the death penalty for sin by bearing the punishment on the Cross (as seen in the woman caught in adultery in John 8). We do not judge the soul's destination, but we are commanded to judge actions so that the person can change. Judging actions according to the Word is the right thing to do.

"Who is he that condemns?" They quote Romans 8:1: *"There is no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus."*

The key phrase is "in Christ Jesus." This applies to those who no longer live in sin. If you are living in sin, you are not covered by this immunity. We are allowed to judge your present actions to bring you to repentance.

Conclusion

In the church, discipline is applied not to destroy people, but to correct them. When a member is asked to sit at the back or step down from a department, it is not punishment, it is correction. This is love, not condemnation. Correction is meant to restore character and bring repentance.

You must understand judgment properly, just as you understand agriculture. Agriculture has different branches, farming, poultry, forestry, yet they all belong to one subject. In the same way, judgment has different forms: legal judgment, moral judgment, and biblical judgment.

In a court of law, a judge listens to the case before passing sentence. But when the church corrects you, it is not sentencing you to prison or death—it is calling you back to righteousness.

The Bible says in James 5:19–20: *“Brethren, if anyone among you wanders from the truth, and someone turns him back, let him know that he who turns a sinner from the error of his way will save a soul from death and cover a multitude of sins.”* Correction saves lives.

False Grace in Today’s Church

Many people today attend churches where pastors approve and tolerate sin. They allow women to dress half-naked—wearing leggings, bikinis, short skirts, mini-skirts, and exposing outfits. They permit tattoos, heavy makeup, and false eyelashes that hide God-given beauty.

They allow men to wear earrings, plait their hair, sag their trousers, and live carelessly. They tolerate fornication, clubbing, worldly music, masturbation, homosexuality, same-sex marriage, body alterations, breast or butt enlargement, transgenderism, and other forms of rebellion against God. When correction comes, they shout, “Stop judging me!”

They are bold in sin because their pastors have lied to them, saying:

“God does not look at the outward appearance,” without understanding what Scripture truly means.

“God will not send women to hell for how they dress.” “Jesus said no one should judge you.”

“Don’t let anyone intimidate you.” “You are only sinning against your body, not against God.”

These teachings are deception.

The Truth They Ignore

The Bible says your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit. When you defile your body, you sin against God Himself (1 Corinthians 6:19–20). Sin is not private. Sin is rebellion against God.

Run away from churches and leaders who refuse to correct sin. Do not follow pastors who twist Scripture to please people. They are not servants of God; they are servants of compromise.

Do not be deceived. The Bible warns that there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth for those who refuse to repent. (Matthew 8:12).

If you say, “It is my life and my body; I can do what I like,” then you do not understand sin and you do not understand salvation.

Stop claiming persecution when you are being corrected. Stop calling correction “judgment.” Open your Bible. Learn the difference between Old Testament judgment and New Testament correction. Accept rebuke, repent, and live. Correction is mercy. Reproof is love. Repentance is life. Choose life.

Personal Prayer

"Lord Jesus, I thank You for Your Word which brings light and understanding. I ask for the grace to distinguish between condemnation and loving correction. Help **me** to live a life that honors You, avoiding sin not out of fear of man, but out of love for You.

Where **I** have erred, grant **me** the humility to accept correction and return to Your path. I surrender **my** actions and **my** heart to Your righteous judgment alone. Strip **me** of every pride that rejects Your truth. In Jesus' mighty name, Amen."

Message 11

HOW THE KINGDOM OF HEAVEN SUFFERS VIOLENCE

In the scriptures, it is written that the Kingdom of Heaven suffers violence. But what do you think this violence actually is? What causes the Kingdom of Heaven to suffer violence? Understanding this is crucial because many people have misinterpreted this passage, and they continue to do so. Today, however, you will come to a true understanding.

As recorded in Matthew 11:12, the Bible says: *"And from the days of John the Baptist until now, the kingdom of heaven suffers violence, and the violent take it by force."*

The Mission of John the Baptist

To understand this, the first thing you must grasp is the mission of John the Baptist. What was his mission? Did John the Baptist come merely to pray? Did he come just to sing? No. He came to prepare the way for the Lord. His mission was to prepare the way through announcement—announcing the Kingdom of Heaven and the Kingdom of God.

The Bible states that from the days of John the Baptist—meaning from the days when the Word began to be preached and salvation came to mankind—the Kingdom of Heaven suffered violence. Why?

The Nature of the Battle

Do you think Satan is fighting Heaven itself or perhaps God? Can Satan fight the throne of God? He cannot even get near it. The Kingdom of Darkness cannot fight Heaven directly. So, how does the Kingdom of God suffer violence?

The enemy saw that salvation was coming to mankind. He saw that many people were about to be rescued and saved from hell into the Kingdom of Heaven. Therefore, the devil began his fight. But who is he fighting? He is not fighting the Kingdom of Heaven directly; he is fighting you to prevent you from entering it.

When you hear that the Kingdom of Heaven suffers violence, it means the devil is fighting to stop you from entering the Kingdom of Heaven, and the Kingdom of Heaven is working hard to get you in. The scripture says only the violent take it by force. But how can you be violent? Do you think violence is found only in prayer? Prayer alone does not make you violent. Singing alone does not make you violent.

What makes you violent is **righteousness**. Knowing the Word and being a doer of the Word makes you violent in the spirit. The devil hates it when you are a true child of God because your name is written in the Book of Life. So, the devil works hard to make sure God removes your name from the Book of Life by tempting you to sin; this is exactly what the violence is all about.

When you see people who are holy, the world may mock them and say, "*You are too spiritual.*" They say this because you are violent in the spirit. It is not about speaking in tongues without understanding ("kakaku, kakaka"); if you do all those things but do not have the Word, it is useless.

The Battle for Your Soul

If you are not violent (righteous), you cannot take the Kingdom. You cannot be lukewarm; you must be hot. To be hot is to be in Christ Jesus and to do the will of God. The devil wants you to live in sin. But you must say, "No, I cannot live in sin."

James 4:7 commands us: "*Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.*"

For the Kingdom of Heaven to suffer violence, it is not merely about prayer. That is where everyone's mind goes—they quote the Bible while praying, yet they do not know the real meaning. It is not your fasting or your prayer; it is your eternal life. It is your relationship with God.

The devil is always violent, trying to separate you from God, so you must be violent in doing what is right. It is not easy. Have you ever battled with your mind? Have you ever been in a situation where you said, "No, I can't do this," and you were sweating? That sweating is the result of a battle in your heart and mind. This is spiritual warfare.

Some have refused huge amounts of money offered to them for prostitution, bribery, false witness, fraud, and other sins. If you can do this when you have nothing, then you have started winning the battle. Whenever you say no to sin, you make the devil unhappy and restless; he starts protesting and roaming, seeking a way to bring you down.

Righteousness is your breastplate. Holiness and righteousness are the most important things in the Kingdom. The devil is not fighting your money. He is not interested in your career, your education, or your progress. He is fighting against your reward. He is interested in your soul. Just as God is interested in your soul, the devil wants to capture it. If you allow the devil to win your soul, you have lost.

There is no violence greater than the battle between righteousness and sin, between God's people and the devil's people. The greatest violence occurs when the devil tries to convince you to sin, and you violently resist him with the Word of God.

The Deception of the Enemy

You may think you are fighting in the spirit just because you pray, but if you pray without righteousness, the devil does not fear you. In fact, the devil laughs at you. You may speak in tongues, but do you not know that the devil can speak in tongues too? He is a spirit; he has been there since from the beginning.

I saw a video where a man was manifesting during deliverance and speaking in tongues, and the demon speaking through him said they too speak in tongues in the Kingdom of darkness. Do not be deceived; demons can mimic these things. But they cannot mimic righteousness. The only thing Satan cannot do is to live a righteous and Holy Life.

The Kingdom of Heaven suffers violence because of salvation. The enemy is barring you from entering heaven. Imagine a house that you need to enter, but someone is pushing you back. If you retreat, they stop fighting. But if you confront them and push forward to enter, that is violence. You must enter by force because it's your home and you have access.

The Role of Prayer and Righteousness

John 10:10 says, "The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy, I am come that they might have life..."

The devil's mission is to kill and destroy your spiritual life so that you end up in hell. Jesus came so you would have life. Because Jesus came to give you life, the Kingdom suffers violence as the devil tries to stop you from receiving it. Do not misunderstand, I am not saying you should not pray. As a child of God, you must pray. But prayer must be backed by righteousness.

1 Peter 5:8 tells us: *"Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour."*

You cannot be sober and vigilant just by empty prayer. Many have prayed for 50 years and still died in sin because they prayed without the Word of God in action. You must pray in holiness for the devil to be afraid of you. If you live in sin, the devil is your father, and your prayers are directed to him, not God.

Proverbs 14:34 says, *"Righteousness exalteth a nation: but sin is a reproach to any people."* It does not say "prayer exalts a nation." You can pray all you want, but if corruption and immorality are everywhere, the nation cannot be exalted.

Consider this analogy: If a child is obedient to their parents, and they ask for something special, the parents will give it. But if a child is disobedient and asks for 10,000 Naira, the mother may say, "I don't have it." She will give the child food and water because that is a basic right, but the special requests will be denied. It is the same with God. If you live in sin, your prayer and sacrifice are an abomination. But the prayer of a righteous person is powerful.

Proverbs 28:9: *"If anyone turns a deaf ear to my instruction, even their prayers are detestable."*

Proverbs 15:8: *"The Lord detests the sacrifice of the wicked, but the prayer of the upright pleases him."*

Isaiah 1:15: *"When you spread out your hands in prayer, I hide my eyes from you; even when you offer many prayers, I am not listening. Your hands are full of blood!"*

James 5:16: *"The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective."*

The Armor of God

Finally, let us look at Ephesians 6:12-16. We are not fighting against human beings but against wicked spiritual forces. Fighting against spiritual forces is not by prayer but strictly Righteousness and Faith in God. Therefore, we must put on God's armor. You must stand ready with:

Truth as a belt.

Righteousness as your breastplate.

The Gospel of Peace as your shoes.

Faith as a shield to quench the burning arrows of the evil one.

You must be violent in spirit through righteousness. When you live a holy life, you will be able to pray effectively without guilt or being accused by Satan, and you will secure your victory in the Kingdom of God. The spiritual world operates under a law. If you break the law of God, Satan takes over. But if you continue in righteousness, Victory is yours. A Prayerful Christian is a powerful Christian, but a Righteous Christian is the most powerful Christian.

Personal Prayer

"Heavenly Father, I come before You today, asking for the grace to be truly violent in the spirit—not through empty noise, but through the power of a righteous and holy life. Open my eyes to understand that the battle is for my soul, and give me the strength to resist every strategy of the enemy.

Lord, clothe me in Your full armor. Let righteousness be my breastplate and truth be my belt. When the enemy tries to bar me from entering Your Kingdom, empower me to take my stand by force through obedience to Your Word. Let my life please You, so that when I call upon Your name, Heaven will hear and answer. I declare victory over sin, victory over the flesh, and victory over every power of darkness. In Jesus' mighty name, I pray. Amen."

Message 12

THE WORLD OF 18+

The Trap of "Adult" Licensing: The world of "18+" is often characterized as a world of immorality: a realm of indecency, nakedness, prostitution, drunkenness, smoking, and destruction. This is what people typically have in mind when they hear that term. But let us ask a hard question: if there is a television program or a photograph you do not want a child to see, why do you watch it yourself? You call yourself an adult, yet you participate in the very things you forbid your children from witnessing.

If you tell your child, "It is 18+," God is telling you that, in His eyes, you are also a child. Anything a child cannot watch you should not participate in it, because it is rooted in immorality. What is good for the gander is good for the goose—if a video is wholesome, it should be good for everyone. As a child of God, you must not destroy your spiritual body and soul by consuming corrupt content. You may think like an adult in the world, but spiritually, you must remain an innocent child.

The Childlike Path to Heaven

Do not let the "World of 18+" mindset get into your head. As a young person, do not believe that turning 18 gives you the license to do whatever you like. That spirit leads to destruction. Jesus said:

"Verily I say unto you, Except ye be converted, and become as little children, ye shall not enter into the kingdom of heaven." (Matthew 18:3)

If you want to make heaven, you must stay away from the "18+" mentality. You have a Father in heaven who cares for you and does not want His children to go astray, look at naked people, or listen to explicit music. Programs like Big Brother Naija are filled with immorality; if they are not good for children, they are not good for you. Do not rush to behave like a worldly adult by wearing bum shorts, bikinis, leggings, or heavy makeup that masks your true identity.

Spiritual Infants, Mental Adults

The devil uses the "adult" concept to destroy our youth. The Bible instructs us:

"Brethren, be not children in understanding: howbeit in malice be ye children, but in understanding be men." (1 Corinthians 14:20)

When it comes to evil, remain an infant. You may be 50 or 60 years old, but if you watch pornography or consume content featuring immorality—whether you are married or single—you are living in the world of 18+, and God is far from you. If you come across such content on social media, block the profile immediately; there is a demonic spirit behind it. You act as a "parental control" for your children, yet you refuse to let God control you. How can God be pleased when you consume what comes from the enemy?

The Loss of Shame

Society has lost its sense of shame. Some parents allow their children to participate in immorality or smoke because "that is how they grew up." Consider alcoholism: you see "18+" written on beer, yet an adult will sit in a bar and drink five bottles. If you saw a child smoking or drinking, you would intervene to save their life. How much more does God feel when He sees you sinning? God is our greatest Father, the Creator of all, and He is watching you everywhere. Do not think that because you are an adult, you are "on your own."

"For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus." (Galatians 3:26)

"But whoso keepeth his word, in him verily is the love of God perfected." (1 John 2:5)

Consider this: if you send a child on an errand, they often go instantly. If you send an adult, they may move sluggishly or give excuses. To make heaven, you must obey God instantly, just like a child. Do not follow the path of "Yahoo boys" whose only aim is to make money quickly; true wealth comes from God's power and honest labor.

The Power of Appearance and Conduct

Your appearance matters. If you dress like a prostitute, do not be surprised if you attract those looking for such. If you dress with dignity, like a professional or a banker, people will greet you with respect.

Indecency is rampant, women wearing revealing clothes, trousers and leggings, tight clothes, and men sagging their pants, etc.

This lack of fear and respect is the fruit of the "adult" mindset. In universities today, students join cults and engage in violence because they want to "belong." Decent girls enter school and are misled into corrupt practices because they want to appear grown.

Protecting the Little Ones

Do not rush into worldly habits just to prove you are grown. I recall a Deeper Life Church wedding where the photographer asked the groom to carry and kiss his wife for a photo. The groom refused, saying, "I cannot do that in public; children are here watching." He understood that private acts should remain private to protect the innocence of children.

When you display worldly behavior in public, you may cause a child or the righteous to stumble. Jesus warned: *"Whoever causes one of these little ones who believe in Me to stumble, it would be far better for such a person to have a heavy millstone tied around his neck and be thrown into the deep sea."* (Matthew 18:6)

Conclusion

The world is not your home. If you are a Christian, be a true Christian. We are all equal in God's sight; He will judge everyone with the same standard, for He is no respecter of persons. Obey your Heavenly Father. In regard to evil, be an infant. In your thinking, be a mature adult. Behave like a child of God to enter His Kingdom.

Personal Prayer

"Heavenly Father, I come before You today acknowledging that You are the Father of all. Lord, please strip me of the pride and arrogance of adulthood that leads me into the 'World of 18+' and destruction. Grant me the heart of a child—innocent, obedient, and humble before You.

Help me to guard my eyes, my mind, and my actions, so that I may not be a stumbling block to others or to my own soul. Give me the grace to flee from immorality, indecency, and every evil way. May I be an infant regarding evil but mature in my faith, that I may be worthy to enter Your Kingdom. In Jesus' mighty name I pray, Amen."

Message 13

MARKETERS OF IMMORALITY

There are countless ways people unknowingly market sin. Just as God looks for vessels to preach His word—appointing and anointing men—the devil is also recruiting his own agents to market his kingdom. He seeks people to spread the message of immorality and market the things that lead others to sin.

Tragically, many of these marketers are not declared agents of the devil; they are Christians. You call yourselves believers and churchgoers, yet your activities, businesses, and lifestyles lead others into temptation. Immorality is being marketed to us online, through music, and through the services.

Many today reject the things of the Lord because they prefer the things of the world. When the true gospel is preached, they turn away, preferring to listen to what soothes them. However, if you only hear what you like, it is likely not the truth, for the truth is often bitter, and what is bitter makes you better; it is rarely sweet to the flesh. If someone corrects you when you are committing a sin and it feels sweet, you are likely not being corrected at all. But if it hurts you, it is a sign that you need to change.

We are not begging you to follow Christ; we are cautioning you, raising an alarm. By revealing the dangers of immorality, we hope to help you separate yourself from the world and find repentance. Marketers of immorality are everywhere. They advertise for Satan by producing, selling, or doing things that cause others to stumble.

Jesus warned in Matthew 18:6–7: *“If anyone causes one of these little ones—those who believe in me—to stumble, it would be better for them to have a large millstone hung around their neck and to be drowned in the depths of the sea. Woe to the world because of the things that cause people to stumble! Such things must come, but woe to the person through whom they come!”*

Do not allow Satan to use your business, your mouth, your creativity, or your products to market his agenda. You may say, “Satan is not using me” but Satan does not need your permission to use you if you market sinful products.

HOW PEOPLE MARKET IMMORALITY/SIN

1. Through Immoral Businesses and Services: You market immorality when your business does not glorify God. If you do not sell the instrument of sin, people will not buy it from you. If a specific sinful service is not offered in a town, those desiring to commit that sin might abandon the idea. For example, if someone wants butt enlargement surgery but no one offers it and they cannot travel abroad, they will likely forget it. But when you make these things accessible, you become an accessory to their sin.

Below are a few examples:

(a) Club Owners and Beer Parlors: If you own a club or beer parlor, you are marketing immorality. Nothing done in a nightclub glorifies God. You may be a Christian who sows the highest seed, but if your business leads people to hell, you are heading there too. You are inviting drunkards to congregate, smoke, and fall into immorality.

(b) Selling Indecent Clothing: If you sell mini-skirts, bum shorts, leggings, female trousers, or revealing clothes, you are selling sin. You may not wear them, but you sell them to others. The producers of these items have an agenda that is not of God. A true Christian will not produce or sell what leads others to sin. Faith without work is dead; you cannot claim to have faith while your business fuels lust.

(c) Selling Fake Body Parts: Selling fake butts, hips, or enlargement items is deceptive. It makes men lust after what is not real. If a man marries a woman based on these deceptions and later discovers the truth, it can lead to aggression, divorce, or even murder. If you offer enlargement services for body parts, you are marketing or promoting immorality.

(d) Betting and Gambling: Running a betting shop leads people to sin. People steal, fall into depression, commit suicide, or turn to alcohol because they lost their money. You, the business owner, are responsible for facilitating this destruction. You are distributing sin.

(e) Bleaching Creams: When you sell bleaching creams, you turn “black to white.” You encourage people to alter God’s creation. If the sellers stop selling,

the users will stop using them. By stocking these items, you keep the cycle of sin going.

(f) Pirated and Counterfeit Goods: Selling fake or pirated goods causes pain. A buyer may use their last savings to buy a product, only to find it is fake. This can lead to fighting, malice, and even murder.

(g) Abortion Pills: If you are a pharmacist or health specialist selling abortion pills, you are participating in killing. If you refuse to sell them and offer godly advice instead, you save your hands from blood. But if you sell them for profit, you are a marketer of immorality.

(h) Plastic and Cosmetic Surgery Services: If you are a cosmetic or plastic surgeon who helps people with butt, breast, or hip enlargement, or helps reshape or change someone's look, color, nose, etc., you are a marketer of immorality. You advertise lust and fuel sin. Many have died, deceived others, or had their bodies decay because of these sinful services and activities.

(i) Pornography: If you sell items with naked or half-naked images or explicit movies—common in places like Alaba—you are distributing demonic energy. The mere sight of these things causes people to commit adultery in their hearts. You are a direct marketer of immorality and promoter of sin.

(j) Online Blogging: For bloggers, newscasters, or even individuals who share or post immoral content in the name of news, you are marketing immorality. When you hear that there is a sex tape somewhere or that a man was caught sleeping with a woman, do not share the photos or videos. While some see it as news, others commit sin because of that exposure. You are the cause and a partaker of sin, because if you hadn't shared it, they wouldn't have watched it.

2. Producing Explicit Content

Content creators, musicians, and comedians often produce videos that promote nakedness and immorality to get views. This is “blood money.” Occultic men may kill one person, but an immoral content creator kills millions of souls spiritually. There is no comedy in heaven. If your skits make people lust, steal, or emulate bad behavior, you are an instrument of the devil.

Influencers who go naked, show off parts of their bodies, or make sexy moves in indecent dresses online to trend are marketing immorality and will face judgment unless they repent. You, the follower, should immediately

unfollow; else, you will get their reward on the last day—wherever they are, there you shall be.

3. Through Evil Communication

Immorality is marketed through words: praising evil, giving bad counsel, gossiping, slandering, lying, and spreading false news. If you are a blogger posting lies for views, or a teacher preaching false doctrines to please the crowd, you are marketing sin. If your words corrupt a soul, you are liable.

4. Through Referrals and Invitations

Referring people to witch doctors or false prophets, or inviting friends to clubs and sinful gatherings, is marketing immorality. You are acting as a bridge to sin.

5. Through Fashion & Artificial Beauty

Selling Indecent dressing such as bum shorts, female trousers, bikinis, revealing clothes, attachments, wigs, eye contacts, makeups, etc. makes you a marketer of immorality and agent of marine kingdom. If you stop selling, they stop buying.

Wearing indecent clothes markets sin. When you dress indecently, you cause others to stumble. God will not turn disobedience into righteousness just because everyone is doing it. As a child of God, cover your body and appear responsible. The way you dress is the way you will be addressed both on earth and in heaven.

Never listen to those who say, “God does not look at outward appearance.”

Your “outward appearance” (in that context) refers to your physical features or stature, not your clothing choices.

If God will not judge your dressing, then nobody is going to hell, because indecency is the pillar of lust and sexual immorality; that is why the Bible strongly condemns indecency.

6. Through Reactions and Lifestyle

Your actions, such as public displays of romance, can lead others to sin.

The Wedding Illustration: I recall a time I covered a wedding at a Deeper Life Bible Church in Port Harcourt. After the wedding, the photographer asked the groom to kiss the bride.

The groom refused, saying, “No, that is not how we do it here. I cannot carry my wife or kiss her in front of everyone.” The photographer insisted, but the groom stood his ground, explaining that such intimacy is for the secret place, not for the public where children are watching. That man had wisdom. When you kiss or embrace intimately in public, you may incite lust in others. This is an example of doing the right thing in the right way, avoiding the marketing of lust.

7. Anger and Revenge

Seeking revenge or reacting violently creates a chain reaction of sin.

CONCLUSION

Do not be a mouthpiece for the devil. Let whatever you produce, wear, sell, or say glorify God. If you are currently selling filthy items or rendering immoral services, stop now. Change your ways, and God will change your situation. He can give you a better business and a better life.

As Romans 1:32 warns: *"Who knowing the judgment of God, that they which commit such things are worthy of death, not only do the same, but have pleasure in them that do them."*

Let Jesus be the Lord of your business, your money, your dressing, and your tongue. If He is not Lord of all, He is not your Lord at all.

Personal Prayer

“Heavenly Father, I come before You today with a humble heart. I ask for forgiveness for the many ways I have unknowingly marketed immorality through my business, my words, and my lifestyle. Lord, purge my hands from every trade that does not glorify You. Sanctify my tongue and purify my heart. Give me the grace to be a true ambassador of Your Kingdom, leading men to righteousness rather than sin. I pray for the courage to separate myself from the world and to stand for the bitter truth that saves, rather than the sweet lies

that destroy. Let Jesus be the undisputed Lord over my finances, my choices, and my eternal destiny. In Jesus' mighty name, I pray. Amen.”

Message 14

PARENTAL DECEIT

Many things happen in families when parents deceive their children into living a lifestyle that does not align with the Lord. The Bible says in Proverbs 22:6: "Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it." If you want your child to follow the right path, you must train them from the very beginning.

Many parents allow their children to live in sin, dismissing it by saying, "It's just a child. Let them be." But as they grow, that sin takes root deep inside them. You are planting a seed that will germinate. You cannot plant a tree and decide to move it once it has grown deep roots; uprooting it requires immense effort and could make it wither.

When you raise a child in the way of the Lord, those teachings take root—childhood memories can never be lost. Even when trials and temptations come, they will stand firmly. Many children misbehave when they leave home not because they were born bad, but because they lacked proper upbringing.

Parental Responsibility and Authority

Even if some well-trained children choose to follow the world, as a godly parent, it is your responsibility to correct them. Never stop guiding your children, no matter how old, wealthy, or outspoken they become. No child has more authority than their parents, just as no one is greater than God.

Ephesians 6:1-4 commands: *"Children, obey your parents in the Lord: for this is right... And ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord."*

Without this discipline, children may become rebellious, fighting you and allowing Satan to occupy their lives.

Consider the behavior of some children today; some join cults, while others become "Yahoo boys." Conversely, disciplined children in school will refuse to share snacks or ice cream from others because they were trained not to eat from strangers or drink from shared cups. Training defines them.

However, some parents train their children in indecency. You allow a child of five or six to wear underwear or "pants" as outerwear, claiming "she is just a child." As they grow, they normalize wearing tights and inner wear outside because you taught them it was normal; you made them feel comfortable in that dress. They will keep this evil until they see the light and draw back.

Whatever clothing you would not want your child to wear when they grow up, do not dress them in it now. This is especially important for girls. Avoid clothing such as bikinis, short skirts, bum shorts, or female trousers.

Dressing a child in these and excusing it with "she is just a child" can create problems later. When she grows older, she may say, "I am an adult now; I can wear what I want," or, "I feel uncomfortable in long skirts and gowns; I prefer a bikini because it gives me freedom." This type of freedom can lead her into dangerous paths, and as a parent, you share the responsibility if you fail to guide her properly.

Living by Example

Do not assume you are safe just because you go to church. If you plant ungodly seeds, you will face judgment. You cannot instruct your children to be godly if you are sleeping around, fighting, or slapping your spouse in their presence. Children are like photocopying machines; they copy what you do and may eventually do worse. You pray for your children to be greater than you in blessings, but are you also praying for them to be greater than you in evil?

As a Christian, you must raise them in the way of the Lord. If they go astray, the seed you planted will eventually recall them home, like the Prodigal Son. *"I will arise and go to my father, and will say unto him, Father, I have sinned against heaven, and before thee."* (**Luke 15:18**) But if there is no seed and no "home" to look back to, they will keep climbing the mountain of destruction with no place to return.

Therefore, teach your children, especially females, to dress well. Indecent dressing can lead them astray. Some churches fail to teach discipline and focus only on success and well-being. You must discipline your children so that when they grow, your hand is no longer needed because God will guide them.

Discipline vs. Pampering

In their youth, demons may tempt children to feel bored or entitled, comparing themselves to those who made money illegally. Like the Prodigal Son, they may leave, but the suffering outside will eventually force them to realize that their father's house is better. Do not grant them total freedom to be destroyed. Some parents have had to go as far as sending their children to rehabilitation or correctional facilities to separate them from bad influences. This is a form of deliverance.

Do not over-pamper children, or they may grow up without resilience or responsibility. Research shows that children who are never denied anything or corrected often struggle with self-control and accountability later in life. Parents must sometimes say no, limit material things, and require hard work so children learn patience and the value of effort.

Giving children age-appropriate tasks or small paid jobs helps them understand responsibility and reward. Discipline is also necessary, but it should be consistent and corrective, not abusive. While harsh punishment can harm a child, the absence of discipline is equally damaging.

Some parents don't want their children disciplined. I heard of a parent who invited a teacher who flogged their child home and then slapped the teacher. This is bad! If you try to save the child's life by shielding them from correction, you will lose them. Having excess money does not mean living in excess. Children must learn both comfort and hardship to develop discipline and resilience. When they grow up knowing only ease, they often struggle when things go wrong—this is why many rich kids end up ineffective or disconnected in society.

Guarding Their Hearts and Minds

Nobody is truly free; even wives submit to husbands, and we all submit to God. Operate within your level of authority. If a child disobeys, do not provoke them, but train them to adapt. If they must drink garri, let them do it contentedly. If you expose them only to the "high life," they will refuse to come down, preferring to join militants or scammers to maintain that lifestyle.

Guard them against bad friends. Do not encourage "boyfriends" and "girlfriends", this leads to premature sex, pregnancy, and heartbreak.

Do not spare the rod. **Proverbs 29:15** tells us: *"The rod and reproof give wisdom: but a child left to himself bringeth his mother to shame."* Flog them in love to reset their understanding, just as God punishes us for sinning even after forgiving us.

Live by example. If you smoke or act immorally in front of them, they will replicate it. I recall a story from primary school where two nursery pupils were caught romancing each other in the bathroom; they admitted they were simply copying what "Daddy and Mommy do."

Spiritual Investment

Pray for your children constantly. Read the Bible to them and let them also read. Just as they need school certificates, they need the knowledge of the Kingdom of God to pass the tests of life. Your spiritual battles are real. If you are a womanizer, a singer, or a police officer, your children often pick up these traits. It is a spiritual lineage; what you belong to determines your productivity and your children's future.

Restrict them from worldly songs and television programs that glorify sex and violence. If you allow them to feed on Satan's content, you are digging a pit for yourself. Drill them in the Word of the Lord, which is more important than university degrees.

Conclusion

Finally, remember that broken homes breed broken children. If you divorce or nag your spouse, your children will likely repeat that cycle. Be mindful of social media; do not use your children for comedy skits that expose them to the world early. It prepares doom for their future. Choose a church that preaches the true gospel, not just miracles. Teach your children hard work, humility, and how to live a simple and decent life.

Personal Prayer

"Heavenly Father, I come before You today acknowledging that my children are Your heritage. I ask for the grace to train them in the way they should go, planting seeds of righteousness that can never be uprooted. Lord, forgive me for the times I have led them astray by my examples or negligence. Protect my children from the deceptions of this world, bad company, and the enemy's snares. In Jesus' mighty name, I pray. Amen."

Message 15

HOW SINNERS THINK

There is a specific way every sinner thinks; they possess a mindset that justifies their actions. We must ask: What encourages them to keep committing sin? What keeps them where they are? For some, sin is like a business. Just as a child of God is encouraged to live righteously because they know their destination, sinners are encouraged by what they see, believe, and are told. They are often unwilling to cross over to the side of Jesus Christ because they love their current state.

There are specific reasons why they remain in sin—some reasons may seem logical to them, but they are spiritually dangerous. Below are few Reasons.

The Barrier of Guilt and Unbelief: The first major reason is the belief that God cannot forgive them. Many in the streets refuse salvation because they think, "I have done too many terrible things. God won't accept me." They forget that Jesus forgave the thief on the cross. There is no amount of sin God cannot erase. The question is not about the weight of your sin, but about your willingness to change.

Jesus is willing to forgive you, but you must first forgive yourself. You must resolve in your mind to stop the sin; that is where forgiveness begins. You cannot ask for forgiveness while holding onto the act. God is actively looking for the "worst" sinners. Why? Because if a notorious armed robber or a powerful native doctor gives their life to Christ, it becomes a sign to others. People will say, "If that man can change, why am I still sinning?" Do not let the fear of rejection keep you from God. He loves the world, specifically the perishing—and wants to save you.

The Deception of Atheism and False Philosophies: Another mindset is the denial of God's existence. **Psalm 53:1** tells us, "*The fool hath said in his heart, There is no God.*" Yet, many claim God is merely a human invention or rely solely on science, which is foolishness to God. Consequently, they believe there is no Heaven or Hell, arguing that life ends here on earth. This belief, often reinforced by false teachings or skepticism, removes the fear of consequences, leading them deeper into sin.

Similarly, some argue that Christianity is a "white man's religion" brought to deceive Africans, urging a return to traditional rituals. This dangerous mindset traps people in occult practices that eventually demand high prices, including human lives.

The Demand for Signs and Fear of Poverty: Some sinners are hard to convert because they demand signs and wonders; without seeing power, they will not believe. Others reject salvation out of a fear of suffering. They look at a preacher's shoes or lifestyle and assume following Jesus means poverty. This is a lie. God's blessings make one rich and add no sorrow. Wealth gained outside of God eventually brings pain, often when it is too late to cry for help. Religion does not limit your potential for prosperity; rather, being one with God enhances it.

The Danger of Blind Faith: Many are led astray because they follow human leaders rather than the Word of God. If they were taught in school that $5x - 2 = 1x$, they believed it. If told later it equals 4, they believed that too. In the same way, people blindly trust their pastors, even when those pastors contradict the Bible. They argue, "My pastor walks in the Holy Ghost, he cannot be wrong!"

Brethren, faith should be built on God's Word, not just on a pastor's opinion. You must study the Bible for yourself. Some churches today have become places of manipulation, focusing on money and fabricating testimonies. Do not let the hypocrisy of a few keep you from the truth of God.

Procrastination and the Abuse of Grace: A dangerous group of people are those who say, "I am not ready." I have met people who admit their lifestyle is wrong but claim they need to "finish" what they are doing first. They want to enjoy the pleasures of sin—partying, immorality, crime—before turning to God. This is a deadly gamble. You do not know what tomorrow will hold. Delaying salvation weakens your soul and spiritual man.

Others abuse the concept of mercy. They sin willfully and say, "God is merciful, He understands." While God is merciful, mercy is for the merciful. You cannot continue in sin and expect grace to abound. *"What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? God forbid."* (**Romans 6:1-2**)

You cannot ask someone to wash you while you willfully stay in the mud. You must step out of the mud to be cleansed.

The Myths of "Enjoyment" and Reincarnation: The world promotes the idea: "Enjoy life today, for tomorrow you may die." This hedonistic mindset drives people to clubs and reckless living. Others believe in reincarnation, thinking they will come back to fix their mistakes. This is a deception.

The Bible says: *"And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment."* (**Hebrews 9:27**). There is no second chance after death.

Purgatory: Another reason many people continue in sin is because they believe there is purgatory, where sinful souls will receive forgiveness before entering heaven. My dear, there is nothing like purgatory. After death, judgment follows.

If there were purgatory, then there would be nothing like hellfire, because no one would go to hell. Jesus would simply forgive everyone in the end. If that were the case, the death of Jesus would be in vain, and He should not have come in the first place.

Do not be deceived by any priest or pastor who tells you there is purgatory, that there is no hell, or that grace covers you while you continue in sin. Ask them a simple question: have they been to purgatory or to hell?

God's Standard is Holiness

God will judge everyone by the same standard. You cannot bargain with God or enter His kingdom through tricks.

"For there is no respect of persons with God." (**Romans 2:11**)

Some think they can wait until they are old to repent, but death often comes without warning—in sleep or by sudden accident. The time to repent is now.

Do not be deceived by the ritual of repetitive confession. Some believe that simply saying, "Forgive me, Father," erases their sin so they can go back and do it again. God looks at the heart. True repentance means stopping the sin. If a child keeps breaking things at home and apologizing, eventually the apology loses meaning. But when the behavior stops, the change is undeniable.

Some rely on the doctrine of "Once saved, always saved," believing their salvation allows them to sin freely. This is false. People love darkness because their deeds are evil; they hide in dark clubs and corners to conceal their actions.

But if you want freedom, you must step into the light. Proverbs 14:12 warns, *"There is a way which seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death."*

Do not create your own way to Heaven. Like the days of Noah, the Ark of Salvation is moving. Enter it now, before the door closes.

Conclusion

Do not give excuses to sin. *"If I had not come and spoken unto them, they had not had sin: but now they have no cloke for their sin."* (**John 15:22**). Do not emulate sinners or be partakers of sin, for God will judge alone, not another on your behalf. *"So then every one of us shall give account of himself to God."* (**Romans 14:12**).

See the truth, buy the truth, and do not sell it. *"Buy the truth, and sell it not; also wisdom, and instruction, and understanding."* (**Proverbs 23:23**)

Confessing to a reverend father does not mean your sins are forgiven if your heart is not changed. Forsake your sins first, ask God to forgive you, and it is erased. No excuse can turn your sin into righteousness or make God overlook it, even if you choose the sin over death, for it is better to die in the Lord than to die in the world.

He who has an ear, let him hear. No matter your mistakes, Jesus is willing to accept you back.

Do not condemn yourself; say to yourself, "Jesus Loves Me." Act today by giving your life to Christ or stopping that particular sin you commit. No sinner will enter the Kingdom of Heaven, or else Satan would also enter.

Personal Prayer

Heavenly Father, I come before You, acknowledging that You are the God of truth and mercy. Lord, forgive me where my heart has been trapped in the deception of sin. Break every wrong mindset, false belief, and spirit of procrastination in my life. Open my eyes where I have been blinded by worldly pleasures or fear of tomorrow. Give me the courage to step out of darkness into Your marvelous light. I silence every lie of the enemy, and I declare that today is the day of my salvation. Wash me and transform my heart. Help me to stand on Your unchangeable Word and live righteously. Grant me the grace to remain in the Ark of Salvation until the end. In Jesus' mighty name, Amen.

THE WORLD IS NOT EARTH

If you are asked the meaning of “*the world*,” you might instinctively say it means *the Earth*. However, the world is not the Earth. God did not create “*the world*” in this specific spiritual context; He created the Earth. Satan is the architect of the world system. The world as a place is not physical but has physical activities called worldly things and inhabitants called sinners.

In this spiritual sense, “*the world*” refers to a community of sinners and unbelievers—those who are presently not useful to God. This is why Satan is called “*the god of this world*,” because he can rule only over sinners, not over God’s people.

The world functions as the Kingdom of Satan established upon the Earth. Therefore, when you hear the term “*the world*,” it refers to the entity, community, or kingdom of unbelievers located on the planet Earth.

The World System vs. Earth

God created the Earth, but Satan formed the world through sin and disobedience. The world began when Adam disobeyed God. This is why you often hear the phrase “*worldly things*.” The world consists of those who participate in its practices.

If you come into the world, you will find the works of the flesh clearly listed in Galatians 5:19–21: adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies, envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and disobedience. These also manifest today through practices such as tattoos or body piercing, sagging, homosexuality, and other expressions of rebellion against God.

Furthermore, the world is full of indecency—women wearing trousers, tight or skinny clothing, mini-skirts, bum shorts, or other garments that expose their breasts, stomach, or body shape. Those fully immersed in the world are often the ones who foolishly say that there is no God.

The world is like an occultic kingdom, while the Kingdom of God is like a prayer group. Both groups live physically in the same community, yet they belong to different spiritual systems that determine their values, lifestyle, and character. Physically, the occultic group hates the prayer group, while the prayer group reaches out to the occultic group to preach repentance and salvation.

In the World, But Not of It

The Bible says *“you are in this world, not of this world,”* it means that although as a Christian, you are physically present on earth dominated by sinners, your purpose is to transform those who live in sin through evangelism and the power of God not to join them in committing sin.

When you are delivered from this world, it means you are no longer living in sin, even though you still physically reside on earth. You no longer identify with the worldly people nor have things in common with them.

To understand it clearly, the world is a community of those who believe in Satan, live in sin, or have not accepted Jesus Christ as their personal Lord and Savior. This is why the world is called the Kingdom of Satan on earth.

However, there is also the Kingdom of God on earth. The moment you give your life to Christ; you move into the Kingdom of God. Both the world and the Kingdom of God coexist on the same earth like two community within one territory. As a child of God, you can live in God’s Kingdom while physically dwelling on this planet.

Biblical Distinctions

Genesis 1:1 says, *“In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.”* Did the Bible say that God created the world? No. It clearly states that God created the heavens and the earth. The Earth is a planet; the world is not a planet. This distinction explains why Satan cannot rule the Earth, because God rules the physical universe. Satan rules unbelievers—that is, the world.

God’s Love for the World

The Bible says, *“For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life”* (John 3:16).

Notice that the Bible does not say, *“For God so loved the Earth,”* nor *“the Kingdom of God,”* but *“the world.”* What did God love in the world? He loved the sinners trapped in the Kingdom of Satan. He sent His Son to save them so that whoever believes in Him will not perish with Satan in hell.

God loves sinners—that is the meaning of this Scripture. He does not want anyone to perish but desires that all should come to repentance (2 Peter 3:9).

This is why Jesus said, *“They that are whole have no need of the physician, but they that are sick: I came not to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance”* (Mark 2:17).

The Hatred of the World

In John 17:14–16, Jesus prayed: *“I have given them thy word; and the world hath hated them, because they are not of the world, even as I am not of the world...”* Jesus was telling the Father that He gave His disciples the Word, and as a result, the world hated them. You live among sinners on earth, but they hate you because you are not part of their world system.

John 15:19 confirms this truth:

“If ye were of the world, the world would love his own: but because ye are not of the world, but I have chosen you out of the world, therefore the world hateth you.”

Salt and Light

Romans 12:2 instructs us: *“And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind...”* The scripture says *“pattern of this world,”* not *“pattern of this earth,”* to show that the world is an evil system.

Everything you see in the world—its patterns, music, fashion, and customs—you are warned not to imitate.

Matthew 5:14 says, *“You are the light of the world.”*

Matthew 5:13 says, *“You are the salt of the earth.”*

Notice the distinction carefully. Jesus did not say “salt of the world”; He said, “salt of the earth,” and then “light of the world.” This phrasing is intentional. As salt, you add value to the Earth that the Lord created.

However, if you attempt to add value to the "world"—defined here as the sinful system—you would effectively be promoting the kingdom of Satan. Therefore, your role in the world is different: as Light, you shine, precisely because the world is full of darkness.

Conclusion

Before God created the Earth, there was no **“world.”** The world came into existence when sin entered, when man was separated from God’s Love. It was through sin that worldly things appeared.

The Bible promises a New Heaven and a New Earth. God did not say He would create a *“new world.”* After this world passes away, the Earth will be renewed for the children of God.

Finally, brethren, both the world and the Kingdom of God are spiritual realities manifested physically through beliefs and values. *“By their fruit, you shall know them.”* To be in the world but not of it is like entering a river to catch fish. You are in the water, but you are not the fish. You do not belong there, and you do not allow the water to drown you.

Personal Prayer

Lord, I come before You today with a humble heart, seeking the grace to stand firm in Your truth. I acknowledge that while my feet are planted on this earth, my spirit belongs to Your Kingdom. Help me to be the salt that preserves the earth and the light that shatters the darkness of the worldly system.

Keep me from the evil one, just as Jesus prayed. Sanctify my mind and heart so that I do not love the patterns of this world—its fashion, greed, lifestyle or pride. Instead, help me to love Your will and Your ways. Use me, Lord, to transform my community, to evangelize the lost, and to reveal Your glory to those who hunger for righteousness. I declare that I am in this world, but I am not of it. I belong to the kingdom of God. In Jesus’ mighty name, I pray. Amen.

EVERYONE PRAISES WHAT IS EVIL

In today's world, it seems that everyone praises what is evil. People often look only for what favors them rather than seeking what is good or right. They no longer stand for the truth; instead, they take a stance based on personal gain. You might find yourself speaking up for a friend or supporting a parent simply to gain favor, even when they are wrong.

No matter who is involved, you must not involve yourself in anything demonic or sinful. To support evil, to stay silent about the truth, or to condemn the innocent is to partake in evil yourself.

The Digital Support of Sin

Judging or condemning the innocent is a direct way of supporting evil, but there is a more subtle way many Christians fall into this trap: **Social Media**. Consider who you follow online. You follow those who expose their bodies, praising and supporting them. You follow those who sing worldly songs that glorify the devil, and you even donate money to them, attend their shows, listen to their songs, and watch their videos.

This is a guide to help you understand that the Lord detests those who support evil. As a child of God, it is a sin to support wickedness, regardless of the reason, whether online or offline.

It is disheartening to see our young men and women on social media following those who act foolishly or dress explicitly. You may donate to them, yet when you see people doing the work of God, you refuse to follow or support them. When someone posts explicit content, people share it to support the evil; but when someone posts about God, it is ignored.

If you are added to a Christian group to learn the Gospel, you might leave, yet you willingly join and remain in groups that promote immorality. To support what is bitter, dark, and sinful is to condemn what is sweet, light, and righteous. If you support darkness, you cannot belong to the light no matter who you are, you cannot enter the Kingdom of Heaven.

Communication and Promotion

Even your communication can support evil. If someone asks for your opinion on destroying or fighting another person and you say, "Go ahead," you are supporting sin. Promotion is another aspect of this. You might promote evil because you feel it is more popular. For instance, a nude photo online gathers many likes and followers, but the Word of God attracts few.

Even social media algorithms often limit the reach of Gospel content while pushing nonsense. Those who support the world will not follow the truth; instead, they will challenge it.

I once watched a video of a popular secular artist who openly admitted that he sings for the devil. He stated clearly that his songs glorify Satan and do not glorify God. When you follow such people, listen to their music, and dance to it, you are eating their fruit and glorifying the devil yourself. You cannot expect to make Heaven while strictly following the people of the world.

The Scriptural Verdict Isaiah 5:20 says, *"Woe to those who call evil good and good evil, who put darkness for light and light for darkness, who put bitter for sweet and sweet for bitter."* Woe to you if you see what is wrong and call it right.

Proverbs 17:15 adds, *"Acquitting the guilty and condemning the innocent—the Lord detests them both."*

We see this evil in our courts and police stations, where bribes are taken to acquit the guilty while the innocent are jailed. There is a story of a man in America who was sentenced to prison for over twelve years because a young lady falsely accused him of rape. Years later, she confessed that he did not commit the sin, but an innocent soul had already suffered. Supporting evil destroys lives, driving some to prison or even suicide because they could not contain the injustice.

Society's Justification of Sin Psalm 12:8 tells us that *"the wicked strut about when what is vile is honored among men."*

Society tries to justify sin; for example, when a girl walks half-naked on the street, people will praise her and ask if you expect her to dress like a grandmother. This is supporting iniquity. Whether in the court of law, your office, or your home, you must not condemn the innocent.

You must tell the truth, for the truth shall set you free. John 8:32 says, *"Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free."* It is better to die early and make Heaven than to live long and perish in Hell.

Conclusion

Do not be someone who donates to evil associations or sinful causes while ignoring the things of God. You want your name to trend, so you give to the world. God will not support you because you do not support Him. When you pray, He may not answer because you are standing in the camp of the enemy.

This message is vital. If you have been supporting evil, turn away and rededicate your life to Christ. Do not like, comment on, or share evil or sinful posts on social media. When you engage with such content, you encourage them to "mass produce" sin. You become a partaker of their evil and will share in their reward, whether that reward is death, disease, or Hellfire.

Whether it is your husband, wife, or servant, do not take sides with wrong. Stand for the truth.

As Ephesians 5:7 commands: *"Be not ye therefore partakers with them."*

Personal Prayer

"Lord, I ask for the wisdom to discern righteousness in a confusing world and the courage to stand alone for the truth, even when it is difficult. Grant me the strength to withhold my support from anything that grieves Your heart, and use my life as a vessel to champion only what is pure, lovely, and true in Your sight. Amen."

MIRACLES THAT DON'T LAST

Sometimes, you may receive a miracle only to reach a point where it vanishes. The problems return, indicating that the miracle did not last. You might receive money or experience open doors, only for those doors to shut again. You might be healed from a disease, only for the sickness to reverse, or see a demon cast out, only for it to return. Consider a student who takes the first position in class but eventually drops to the last position. Indeed, there are miracles that endure, and there are miracles that do not. If you want your miracle to last, there are specific things you must do and things you must avoid.

I will be discussing different types of miracles: healing, deliverance, and the wealth and riches that people desire. If you have good health, are free from demonic possession, and possess wealth, you are truly okay. Everything else is an addition. With money and health, you can acquire what you desire, but if you are sick, money loses its value; you may not even know where you are or how much is in your account.

The Foundation of a Lasting Miracle

We see people who rise to riches only to become poor, or heroes who fall from the top to the bottom. *Any miracle you receive today without receiving Christ will not last.*

Salvation means being saved, confessing your sins, giving your life to Christ, and staying away from iniquity. If your miracle has faded, check your life—salvation may be missing.

It is only God who gives the power to make wealth. If you disobey God, the miracle cannot sustain itself. The Bible says: *"The blessing of the Lord, it maketh rich, and he addeth no sorrow with it."* (**Proverbs 10:22**)

Romans 8:31 tells us, *"If God be for us, who can be against us?"* But how can God be for you if you are not for Him? If you do not live a holy and righteous life, you are essentially standing against God, leaving you vulnerable. Salvation is the greatest gift to mankind because it opens the doors to deliverance and lasting wealth.

As the scripture says: *"But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you."* (Matthew 6:33)

Do you know what lasting wealth or blessing is? The Abrahamic blessing is a good example. If your blessings do not last, either they are cut short in your own time or they fade away when you die, meaning your children won't enjoy them. A lasting blessing comes from God and is passed down through generations. If you acquire wealth through sin—prostitution, occultism, kidnapping, corruption, robbery, drug trafficking—or without true salvation, then it cannot last.

Obedience and Gratitude

Therefore, for your miracle to last, you must follow Christ, not just to attend church. Going to church for prayers alone or having a popular Man of God as your spiritual father will not save you; you need the process of salvation. You must read the Word, obey it, and maintain gratitude. Miracles without gratitude do not last. Some receive blessings and immediately use them to satisfy the flesh—Womanizing, clubbing, and boasting, thinking it is by their own power.

Some may argue, "Some countries or individuals are rich, yet they do not know God." I pity that perspective. The gods they serve provide for them because they adhere strictly to their own beliefs and altars. Many of these entities demand sacrifices—even human lives—and they keep those rules. Yet, as a child of the Living God, you struggle to keep even one rule of righteousness. You cannot compare yourself to them. You must get so close to God that the devil cannot separate you.

God loves appreciation. Just as you thank your parents after a meal, which encourages them to give you more, you must thank God. You should not come into His presence without an offering of thanksgiving.

"A son honoureth his father, and a servant his master: if then I be a father, where is mine honour? and if I be a master, where is my fear? saith the Lord of hosts unto you." (Malachi 1:6)

Furthermore, continuing to sin after a miracle ensures it will not last. God makes the sun shine on both the good and the bad, but there is a special love and special gifting reserved for the obedient. If you are a stubborn child who suddenly does something good, your parents may surprise you with a gift.

But if you return to bad behavior, that gift will not be renewed. Lasting miracles require continuous obedience. You cannot serve God merely for what you want to receive; you must serve Him because He is God.

Life, sound health, marriage, breakthrough, promotion, a new job, a contract, recovery, deliverance, salvation, liberation, healing, restoration, safe journey, graduation, wealth, and even the ability to sleep and wake up—these are all miracles. Do not take them for granted.

The Danger of Empty Deliverance

The Bible warns us in Matthew 12:43-45 that when an unclean spirit leaves a man, it seeks rest in dry places. Finding none, it says, *"I will return into my house."* If it finds the house empty, swept, and garnished, but void of the Holy Spirit, it brings seven other spirits more wicked than itself. If you receive deliverance but return to your sinful ways, the demons will return. This is why I recommend deliverance of the soul and self-deliverance, which is true repentance.

Even with addiction, if you stop the actions that glorify the demon, it will leave. Demons possess people to make them commit specific sins to glorify Satan; in the same way the Holy Spirit possesses God's children to guide them to live righteously. If you resist and are "rehabilitated" by righteousness, the demon will eventually go far away.

Your miracle requires righteousness to be permanent. Do not rely solely on the faith of your pastor. Jesus wants us to follow Him personally. Even children must learn this; disobedience, lying, and cheating open the door to demonic possession. When you commit sin, you open the door for demons to attack or possess you; similarly, if you live right, you open the door for the Holy Spirit.

Bad friends are often used by demons to trap you. They may not initiate you with rituals, but by planting seeds of sin in you. The devil is not here to stop your wealth; he is here to stop you from obeying God, because he knows disobedience leads to destruction and denial of God's blessings.

Go and Sin No More

Remember the man at the Pool of Bethesda? Jesus healed him but later warned him in John 5:14, *"Sin no more, lest a worse thing come unto thee."*

Your miracle needs a holy life to be sustained. Similarly, in Luke 17, Jesus healed ten lepers, but only one returned to give glory to God. Jesus asked, "Where are the nine?" Only the one who returned was made perfectly whole. Gratitude makes the miracle permanent.

Some say following Jesus is hard, but I tell you, following the devil is suffering and much harder. You feel trapped in Satan, finding it difficult to abandon your sins. The Bible lists these sins clearly in Galatians 5:19-21, Colossians 3:5-9, and 1 Corinthians 6:9-10: Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies, envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, lying, blasphemy, and filthy communication.

This sin is called captivity, and nothing that comes through sin lasts; rather, it leads to everlasting destruction. The world requires terrible sacrifices—killing for power. But in Christ, only your confession is needed, and you will have peace and sanctified by the blood of Jesus Christ.

Divine Harvest

Miracles combined with hard work and righteousness yield great results. God allows you to reap where you did not sow. *"I sent you to reap that whereon ye bestowed no labour: other men laboured, and ye are entered into their labours."* (John 4:38)

This means He makes things easier for you. You might get a contract for 10 million when others bid less, simply because God grants you favor and wisdom. You may finish a project someone else started and take the harvest. This is the advantage of the Kingdom.

God warns that it is hard for the rich to enter heaven because many fail to give or they trust in their wealth. Even in business, spiritual laws control the physical. People of the world keep their occult or ritual rules strictly; as Christians, we must keep God's rules.

Conclusion

For your miracles, deliverance, testimonies, and even marriages to last, you must believe and obey the everlasting King of Glory. God's blessings and protection are for those who fear Him.

To ensure your miracle lasts, you must do the following:

Salvation: You must be born again.

Continue in Righteousness: Live a holy life daily.

Have Faith and Trust in God: Do not waver when challenges come.

Acknowledge and Appreciate God: Maintain a heart of gratitude.

Help the Poor and Needy: Your blessings are seeds for others.

Never Glorify Satan: Avoid worldly songs, dances, and alcoholism, etc.

God will not give you money for you to promote the kingdom of Satan (the world) or give you a miracle for you to claim it is by your power.

Do not be like those who receive miracles—healing, a new home, a new baby, a breakthrough—and during the thanksgiving service or dedication, host a party where they sing and dance to worldly songs and promote alcoholism.

In this way, you are making God jealous because the activities in the celebration are worldly and do not bring glory to Him. Your life, ceremony, business, and daily activities must please God.

Personal Prayer

"Heavenly Father, I thank You for the miracles You perform in my life daily. I ask for the grace to sustain these blessings through salvation, gratitude, and a righteous walk with You. Lord, fill every empty space in my hearts with Your Holy Spirit so that no evil may return. Give me the wisdom to obey Your Word, the strength to resist sin, and the humility to always return all glory to You. May my miracles be permanent, and may my life be a testimony of Your power and love. In Jesus' mighty name I pray. Amen."

Message 19

THE SICKNESS OF THE SOUL

Just as the human body can become physically sick, the soul can also become sick. When you are physically ill, you seek medication and medical attention to recover. In the same way, when the soul is sick, it requires a spiritual cure to be restored.

To understand this, we must first define the soul. The soul is your spiritual nature, your immortal self or second body in the spiritual realm. Just as you are conscious of yourself physically, you also exist as a real being in the spirit. If you were to die today, what would be judged is not your physical body, but your soul. You possess another nature, another personality in the spirit, and whatever you do in the physical realm directly affects that spiritual nature. If you sin, it damages your soul; if you live righteously, it strengthens it.

Defining the Sickness

What, then, is the sickness of the soul? **Sin is the sickness of the soul.** Sin corrupts, weakens, and infects the soul. Whenever you sin, you poison your soul. When sin is practiced continually, the soul becomes spiritually diseased. Just as physical diseases like infections accumulate in the body through unhealthy behavior, sins accumulate in the soul. Every sin committed on earth inflicts damage on the soul, just as diseases damage internal organs. Remember, prevention is better than cure.

When the body is sick, it becomes weak and unable to function. Similarly, a sick soul becomes spiritually feeble. A sick soul cannot endure the race toward eternity. If danger comes and you are told to flee, a sick body cannot run. Likewise, a sick soul cannot rise, cannot endure, and cannot make heaven.

Contagion and Resistance

Sin is committed by choice. Just as there are foods or environments that make the body sick, there are specific sins that infect the soul.

I remember a common eye infection called "Apollo" (conjunctivitis) from my youth. You could avoid it by being careful, but if you didn't, it would affect you. In the same way, when sin presents itself, wisdom demands that you avoid it before it destroys your soul.

The Value of the Soul

Your soul is the most important part of your being. Your flesh will eventually decay and return to the dust, but the soul is eternal. That is why Jesus said:

"And fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather fear him which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell." (**Matthew 10:28**)

Notice that Scripture does not say humans can harm the soul. No human being—and not even the devil—has the authority to destroy the soul. Only God has that authority. This proves that the soul is more valuable than wealth, possessions, family, or even physical life.

When God created man, He formed the soul first and then created the physical body as the visible representation of that soul before giving it life. Your soul, which is your spiritual body, has the same form and identity as your physical body.

Spiritual Nourishment and Healing

Just as you feed your physical body, you must feed your soul with the Word of God, prayer, fasting, righteousness, and holiness. When you live a holy life, your soul becomes strong and healthy. Some people may be physically sick or disabled, yet their souls are spiritually powerful. Regardless of how or when they die, their souls are prepared.

The medicine for a sick soul is righteousness, holiness, repentance, and the Word of God. Many people listen to sermons only for miracles or prophecies. They receive physical healing and return to sin. They do not come for God—they come for benefits. But you must come to God for the sake of your soul. physical miracles are temporary; soul Miracle is eternal.

As a physically sick person goes to the hospital for treatment, so a sick soul must enter the Kingdom of God by surrendering to Christ, which is the hospital. Righteousness is the medicine, and Jesus is the Doctor.

"But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light... the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin." (1 John 1:7)

When you fall into sin, repent immediately without going back. The Blood of Jesus washes the soul clean and makes it healthy.

The Bitter Medicine

The medicine God gives is often bitter—truth, correction, and discipline—but it heals. The devil's "medicine" is sweet at first but ends in destruction. Sweets or Chocolates do not cure diseases; bitter medicine does. What is bitter makes you better, but what is sweet makes you sick.

The end of a sick soul is the **second death**. When a soul dies through persistent, unrepented sin, it is irreparable and ends in hell. But a healthy soul enters eternal rest and finishes the race swiftly.

Conclusion

Your soul is your identity in the spiritual realm. A sick soul prevents righteous living and can cause a person to abandon Christ. Every unbeliever's soul is sick, and the only cure is Dedicating your life to Jesus Christ.

When Christ returns to judge the earth, it is not your physical body that will matter—it is your soul. You will fully understand the reality of the soul after death. Every sin places your soul in danger. Even your dreams can reveal the state of your soul, reflecting how you live daily. Therefore, take care of your soul. Say "No" to sin and Satan. Say "Yes" to Jesus and holiness. These are the nutrients that keep the soul healthy.

Personal Prayer

"Heavenly Father, I acknowledge that just as my body can grow weak, my soul can become sick through sin. I confess that I have often been deceived by the temporary sweetness of wrongdoing, which leads to spiritual bitterness. Today, I ask for the healing medicine of Your righteousness and holiness.

Wash my soul clean with the precious Blood of Jesus—the only true cure. Grant me the strength to embrace the truth of Your Word, even when it is difficult, knowing it produces eternal health. Strengthen my soul to run the race set before me and obtain heavenly rest. In Jesus' mighty name, Amen."

Message 20

SAVED BY GRACE

Many people take the grace of God for granted. They assume that God's grace is something they will just automatically obtain.

However, Paul asked, "*Shall we continue in sin that grace may abound? God forbid.*" (Romans 6:1-2).

Some pastors may teach you based only on human rules without grasping the true spiritual meaning. The Bible says in Ephesians 2:8-9: "*For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast.*"

Some people claim that they do not have to live a righteous life to make it to heaven because grace covers them. That is wrong. God says, "*Be ye holy; for I am holy.*" (1 Peter 1:16). God loves people who live righteously because when you commit sin, the devil comes in.

We are saved by grace through faith. If you believe that Jesus Christ is Lord and obey His word, that is faith. We did not see Him physically; unlike the people who saw Jesus and believed because of what they saw, we believe He was sent by God without seeing Him. That is true faith—believing in Jesus.

The Gift of God

We are indeed saved by grace. The gift God gave us—Jesus Christ—is the evidence of that grace, though many do not realize it.

The scripture says, "*The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Ghost, be with you all.*" (2 Corinthians 13:14). The main grace we are discussing here is salvation.

Jesus Christ is the gift from God. When He came, we did not ask for Him, but God gave Him to us to die for our sins and to forgive us. Being saved by grace means being saved by Jesus. It is a gift you did not work for. However, "not of works" does not mean you should abandon your duties or stop living a righteous life.

It does not mean you can continue to sin thinking grace will abide. That is not how grace works for you.

The phrase "not of works" refers to the coming of Jesus Christ. We did not ask God to send Jesus; nobody worked for it. You were just there, and God sent Him. You did not do any work for God to love you, unlike humans who have to work to gain love and affection.

Now, it is left for you to come to Him so He can redeem you from sin. Ephesians 2:9 says that Jesus came not because of your efforts, but because of the love of God. He loves you, and that is why He sent Jesus to die for us.

Misusing Grace

Therefore, do not use grace as a cover-up for your sin. You cannot continue sinning and say, "Grace covers me." Grace will not cover willful sin. When you truly understand the Bible, you will know that while you did not work to earn grace, God sent His Son out of love. Do not take grace for granted.

Grace cannot work for you if you do not respect it. If you do not respect grace, you will have no role to play in the Kingdom of God. You have a role, and that role is to live right, serve God with all your heart, and teach others to do so for God has good plans for you.

Your teachers, pastors, and priests or even prophets who are influential may say, "Come the way you are, God's grace covers you, remain the way you are, God looks at your heart." Let me ask, is it possible for a mad person to regain his senses without changing his clothing or actions? Capital 'NO'. Once a mad person regains their senses, they become ashamed, take their bath, and change their dressing to appear good, even if they may still need some rehabilitation.

Working Out Your Salvation

This grace we are talking about is a grace you must work out with fear and trembling. Do not just sit down and assume that because Christ died for you, you have nothing to do. You have to work something out. If you become a spiritual fruit, Satan cannot eat you; he will see you are fruit. But when you become flesh, the devil will come and eat you up because he loves blood.

To overcome Satan, you must be spiritual. However, being spiritual is not just about being prayerful or speaking in an unknown tongue; it is about living righteously. Righteousness is the primary boundary that separates you from Satan. The nature of Satan is sin—the very sin you currently commit—while the nature of God is Holiness. You cannot truly claim grace when the nature of Satan still has a strong hold on your life.

Salvation is the first Grace; every other thing—life success, riches without sorrow—comes after salvation.

You cannot continue to sin for grace to abound. If you are useless to God, grace will not cover you. Those who know what is right must do what is right and run away from what is wrong. The only reason Grace covers you is when you live right. It is not just when you pray or fast, but when you live a righteous life. God's grace covers those who obey God's word, not those who live in sin or please their flesh.

Protection and Identity

Protection is free, so you cannot bribe God to protect you. Someone else's grace might cover you for a short time – that is where prayer and intercession work, but it is limited. You are not fully protected until you start obeying God and living a righteous life.

Do not allow anyone to deceive you with the word "grace." Salvation is a gift of God. Jesus came for us to have life in abundance. Stop saying grace will cover you if your lifestyle does not align with God. Does the way you dress represent God? Do people see you as a true Christian? When people see you out there, they should be able to say, "You are a Christian." It is by your works that you show you love God. If you claim to love God, you should work it out.

Conclusion

Finally, grace means God's favor, and a "share in the divine life of God." It is a spontaneous gift from God—generous, free, and totally unexpected and undeserved—that cannot be earned. Salvation is the first gift; without the grace of salvation, no man can be saved. If someone gifts you an expensive item you cannot afford to buy in your lifetime, would you play with it?

Salvation can be lost if not maintained. Everything earned, whether through hard work or gift, whether spiritual or physical, needs maintenance. When you hear "*work out your salvation with fear and trembling*" according to Philippians 2:12, it means work out the grace of God. Show God that you appreciate His favor and gift by obeying His word and staying away from sin.

Dress well and avoid the sins of the flesh, including: fornication, adultery, uncleanness, lasciviousness, idolatry (e.g.: Bowing to the statues of Mary, Jesus and other saints, worshiping idols, visiting native doctors, eating in shrines or giving God's praise to humans and to Satan), witchcraft, hatred, secular songs, makeups and eyelashes, Body reshaping and enlargements, variance, emulations, Kidnapping, Banditry, False teaching and prophecy, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies, envy, revenge, murders, smoking, drunkenness, reveling, indecent dressing (half-naked clothes, revealing garments, bum shorts, female trousers, short skirts, sagging), oppression, masturbation, lesbianism, homosexuality, intimidation, anger, false witness, abortion, hard drugs, land grabbing, clubbing, wicked evil desires, greed, malice, slander, and filthy language, etc. (Galatians 5:19-21, Colossians 3:5-8). Those who live such lives are not under grace and will not inherit the kingdom of God.

Am I condemning you? No. Jesus said in John 3:18, '...but he that believeth not is condemned already.' However, believing needs actions to be proven; you cannot believe in someone without loving, supporting, or following their orders. That is why Jesus said in **John 14:15**: *'If ye love me, keep my commandments.'* *Therefore, if you continue to sin, you don't believe in Jesus because he came to give you freedom from sin not freedom to sin. May God, give you understanding. Amen!*

Personal Prayer

"Heavenly Father, I come before You today with a humble heart. I thank You for the gift of salvation and for sending Your Son, Jesus Christ, to die for me—a gift I did not earn and could never work for. Lord, I ask that You help me never to take Your grace for granted. I refuse to use Your mercy as an excuse to remain in sin. Instead, give me the strength to live a holy and righteous life that pleases You. Let my life bear spiritual fruit so that the enemy has no hold over me. I choose today to work out my salvation with fear and trembling, respecting the great price You paid for my soul. Cover me with Your true grace as I walk in obedience to Your Word. In Jesus' mighty name, I pray. Amen."

Message 21

THE CHRISTLESS IS GODLESS

I do not know where you belong or which religion you profess. Some claim to be Christians yet do not truly believe in Jesus or His divinity. Others belong to religions such as Islam, Hinduism, or Buddhism. Everyone has their beliefs, but the truth remains: if you do not have Christ, you do not have God.

Do not claim to worship God directly while bypassing His Son. Some argue that Jesus is a "white man's god," but who told you that? Jesus spent His early years in Egypt (Africa) and was likely more Middle Eastern or dark-skinned than the European images portray. Let us stop these fallacies. The color of His skin does not matter; His blood does.

The Only Way to the Father

If you believe in Jesus only partially, you do not know God. Jesus said, *"I am the way, the truth, and the life: no one cometh unto the Father, but by me"* (John 14:6).

Therefore, you must fully believe in Jesus and pray in His name to see God. Just as it is impossible to be motherless without being fatherless, you cannot have the Father without the Son. Jesus is the only way that leads to God. As the scripture says: *"Whosoever denieth the Son, the same hath not the Father: (but) he that acknowledgeth the Son hath the Father also."* (1 John 2:23)

God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son to die for you. You cannot enter a company to see the Boss without passing through the authorized process. Similarly, Jesus is the only one who can welcome you into the Kingdom. God is not interested in worship that rejects His Son.

Jesus said, *"He that hateth me hateth my Father also"* (John 15:23). You cannot claim to love a husband while hating his wife; likewise, you cannot obey God while disobeying Jesus. All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to Him. Therefore, do not pray in the name of *"God the Father" alone; pray in the name of Jesus Christ, for "Neither is there salvation in any other"* (Acts 4:12).

It does not matter what atrocities you have committed; if Jesus forgives you, the Father forgives you.

Beware of False Messiahs

Beware of preachers who make themselves gods. For instance, in Calabar, there is a movement where people pray in the name of a man, claiming he is the messiah. There is no Messiah other than Jesus. He is not just a prophet like Mohammed; He is the Son of God who died and resurrected. Another man in Kenya claimed to be Jesus—and people worship and pray to him. This is foolishness of the highest order.

You must give your life to Christ first. Do not rely on long, empty prayers. What you need is belief. God is not deaf. When you pray, have faith. Even if you are poor, do not envy the riches of the world or emulate those who are "shining" without Christ. *"Fret not thyself because of evildoers, neither be thou envious against the workers of iniquity... for they shall soon be cut down."* (Psalm 37:1-2)

Holiness is the Proof of Knowing Christ

A "Christian" who continues to sin is still Christless. Godless is the man who refuses to change. I must speak the truth about sin.

Women, stop wearing trousers, tight clothes, bum shorts, and miniskirts that expose your bodies. You are advertising your body and becoming an instrument of the devil. The fashion of this world passes away. Jesus warned that whoever causes a little one to stumble faces judgment (Matthew 18:6). By dressing indecently, you may lead others to hell.

This warning applies to all sins—killing, witchcraft, oppression, idolatry, gossiping, and adultery. You cheat on your spouse, yet on Sunday, you boldly go to church. This makes you worse than the unbeliever who stays home because they know they are sinners. Church attendance does not save you; repentance does. Stop boasting about your sins. Bad company corrupts good character.

You cannot possess the Kingdom of God if you engage in the acts of the flesh listed in Galatians 5:19-21. To belong to God, you must live a holy life. If you are wearing a white garment, you do not sit on a dirty seat. Keep your garment of righteousness clean.

Culture vs. Christ

Do not be deceived by those who call on "Chukwu Okike Abiama" (the Creator) while rejecting Christ. Jesus performed signs, died, and resurrected—no other "god" did that. You cannot serve two masters. You cannot be a traditionalist and a Christian simultaneously. You must be willing to abandon culture and tradition if they contradict Christ.

Conclusion

God is not forcing you. As it is written, "*Choose you this day whom ye will serve*" (Joshua 24:15). But know this: without Jesus, there is no truth, no way, and no life.

Christ is the Only Way: You cannot bypass the Son to get to the Father.

Partial Belief is Unbelief: You cannot choose which parts of Jesus to believe.

Sin Separates You: Continuing in sin makes you Godless, regardless of your church title.

Culture Must Bow: Any tradition that rejects Christ must be rejected.

Give your life to Christ fully. Stop sinning, dress well, and follow the only true God.

Personal Prayer

"Heavenly Father, I come before You today acknowledging that Jesus Christ is the Way, the Truth, and the Life. Lord, I pray for the grace to fully surrender my life to You, not partially, but wholly. I reject every form of godlessness, every tradition that contradicts Your Word, and every sin that stains my garment of righteousness. Open my eyes to the truth, silence the voices of false prophets, and grant me the strength to turn away from the distractions of this world. Let my life glorify You alone. Wash me clean, forgive my past, and lead me on the path of eternity. In Jesus' mighty name, I pray. Amen."

THE CONSEQUENCES OF SIN

Many people believe they can continue in sin because God will eventually forgive them, or they rely on the concept of Purgatory to cleanse them after death. Do not let anyone brainwash you; the Bible makes it clear that after death, judgment follows. There is no Purgatory, its either Heaven or Hell. *"And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment."* (Hebrews 9:27)

We must understand that there are consequences for every sin. When you commit a sin, you cause damage to your Spirit, Soul, and Body. Consider this: if you cut yourself with a knife, the injury stops where the cut ends. If you stop cutting and treat the wound, it may heal, but the scar remains. That scar serves as a permanent reminder of the injury.

Sin is like a disease or sickness to your soul. Just as malaria requires early treatment to prevent it from worsening, prevention of sin is better than the cure. Even if forgiven, the damage—the scar—often remains.

Here are the specific consequences of sin:

You Make the Land Unclean: Sin defiles the land you occupy. In many villages, there are specific compounds or areas people are warned not to enter, lest they die or face misfortune. This is often because the land was defiled by the sins of the fathers or grandfathers. Sin is contagious; it affects everyone in the vicinity. You may find that suitors refuse to marry into a certain family because of the family's reputation or past lifestyle.

Leviticus 18:25 states: *"And the land is defiled: therefore I do visit the iniquity thereof upon it, and the land itself vomiteth out her inhabitants."*

Just as God punished Egypt for Pharaoh's actions, your lifestyle can cause God to punish your land. When you defile your land, the blessings and good fruits meant for that territory will no longer grow.

You Defile Yourself: Sin makes you unclean. While a believer is a new creature, the consequences of past actions can linger like a scar. Mark 7:20-23 explains what defiles a person comes from within: evil thoughts, sexual immorality, theft, murder, greed, malice, indecency, arrogance, and folly, etc.

When you defile your body, the Holy Spirit can no longer dwell there. Do not be deceived into thinking there are "big sins" and "small sins." All sins are equal before God's standard. While the Bible notes there is a sin not unto physical death—meaning not every sin results in immediate capital punishment like a court sentence—every sin leads to spiritual decay.

You Will Not Enter the Promised Land: The Promised Land represents your destiny and God's blessings. In **Numbers 20**, the Israelites complained about a lack of water. God instructed Moses to speak to the rock, but in his anger, Moses struck the rock twice. Water came out, but God was angry because Moses did not acknowledge His holy power. Consequently, Moses, a great leader, was punished by being denied entry into the Promised Land.

Disobedience can prevent you from enjoying the fruits of your labor. You see people who make money but die before enjoying it or build a house but never live in it. In **Deuteronomy 32:48-52**, God told Moses to climb Mount Nebo to see Canaan from a distance, yet he could not enter. May your efforts never be in vain due to disobedience.

The Land Rejects You: Leviticus 18:26-28 warns that if you do not keep the Lord's commands, the land will reject you just as it rejected the pagans. You might travel to a place like Canada where others are prospering, yet you find no success. You might be in a marketplace where others make sales, but you do not. This is not always the work of "village enemies"; it is often the land punishing you for a dirty lifestyle.

If you live in sin, the land you stand on may turn against you. Conversely, if you live a holy life, you will possess the land, and even when others are rejected, you will be favored.

You Become an Enemy of God: Leviticus 18:29 and James 4:4 make it clear: friendship with the world is enmity with God. If you choose to follow worldly trends, listen to worldly music, or associate with those who do not glorify God, you become God's enemy.

The Devil Becomes Your Father: John 8:44 says, "*Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do.*" When you sin, you align yourself with the devil. God is Holy, and He created us to be holy. Living righteously may seem hard, like a child forced to go to school. Initially, the child cries, but eventually, they adapt and learn. Similarly, when you walk with the Holy Ghost, sin becomes

irritating to you. But if you sin, you claim the devil as your father. *"He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning."* (1 John 3:8)

You Become a Slave: In John 8:34, Jesus says, *"Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whosoever committeth sin is the servant of sin."* A slave has no rights and no say. Romans 6:16 asks who you obey: sin which leads to death, or obedience which leads to righteousness? When you sin, you lose your spiritual freedom and become a slave of Satan.

Demons Enter or Return: Matthew 12:43-45 explains that when an impure spirit leaves a person, it wanders seeking rest. If it returns to find its former "house" (your body) swept clean but empty—meaning devoid of the Holy Spirit and righteousness—it brings seven spirits more wicked than itself. The final condition of that person becomes worse than the first. Deliverance is maintained by holiness. If you stay away from sin, demons will no longer find a place in you because you no longer carry out their works.

God Will Not Answer Your Prayers: Isaiah 59:2 tells us, *"But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid his face from you, that he will not hear."* **1 Peter 3:12** confirms that the face of the Lord is against those who do evil. If you are living in sin, do not be surprised if your prayers are unanswered. You may run to pastors for prayers, and their intercession may help temporarily, but for inconsistent victory, you must live holy. Go to church to hear the Word of God, which brings light, not just for miracles. If your pastor does not preach true salvation, run for your life.

You Become an Agent/Instrument of the Devil: When you commit sin, whether it is the first time or repeatedly, the devil becomes interested in you. If you do not stop, he removes shame from your eyes, blinds you, and causes you to continue in that sin so that you can represent him.

The devil often manifests through sinful lifestyles that appear beautiful but are dangerous. The Bible says, *"In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them"* (2 Corinthians 4:4). Many have become marine, witchcraft, and occultic agents because their sinful lifestyles opened doors for the devil to use them.

You Die a Spiritual Death: Romans 6:23 states, *"The wages of sin is death."* This is spiritual death. When your spirit man is dead, you become vulnerable.

You may find yourself committing sins in your dreams or being defeated in spiritual warfare because your inner man is too weak to fight. Just as a physically hungry man cannot fight, a spirit starved of the Word and killed by sin cannot defend you. Dying a spiritual death also means the Holy Spirit leaves, and you become empty or occupied by evil spirits. A human cannot exist without a spirit driving them; either you have the Holy Spirit or an evil spirit.

Conclusion

Do not say your sin has no punishment because you can do what you want or because you claim to be under grace. Sin is the reason why God cursed mankind, and whoever sins is under God's curse, which comes with punishment. The more you sin, the more you kill your soul. If you die in sin, you are going to hell.

Think of it like a chain smoker. Every stick of cigarette damages the lungs, coating them with tar and destroying the air sacs (alveoli). The smoker may not feel the pain immediately, but the damage is accumulating daily. Eventually, it leads to heart disease, lung cancer, or stroke, and the body collapses. Sin works the same way; you may enjoy it now, but the spiritual toxin is accumulating, leading to inevitable destruction. The more you sin, the more you sink; the more you do right, the more you rise.

Personal Prayer

"Lord Jesus, I come before You today acknowledging that I cannot make it on my own. I ask for the grace to live above sin and the strength to overcome every temptation that tries to defile my life. Heal the scars of my past mistakes and cleanse my land so that I may enter my destiny. Revive my spirit man; let me not be weak in the day of battle, but let Your Word dwell richly in me. I refuse to be a slave to sin or an enemy of Your cross. Wash me clean, restore my fellowship with You, and let my life bring glory to Your name. Amen."

Message 23

THE TRUTH OF THE TRUTH

The reality is that the truth you think you know may not be the ultimate Truth. There is a version of truth that you possess intellectually—facts and figures yet it is not the Truth in its divine essence. We must recognize that while there are lies and there are facts, factual accuracy alone is not the spiritual Truth.

The Truth is a Person: **Jesus Christ**.

This leads us to a profound spiritual reality: if you claim to be a truthful person but you do not know Jesus, you are, in essence, still living a lie. You cannot possess the Truth without possessing the Source of it.

The Truth That Liberates

We must closely examine the common saying, *"The truth will set you free."* In popular culture, people use this to mean that admitting to a mistake or telling the facts will bring relief. But in the Kingdom of God, it is not merely the words you speak that bring freedom. It is Jesus who **is** the Truth who sets you free.

This distinction is vital because He explicitly declared in **John 14:6**: *"Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me."*

Therefore, it is not the act of simply speaking facts that liberates your soul. Consider the practical reality of our world: many people have been sent to prison precisely because they told the factual truth. If speaking facts were the only requirement for freedom, they would be walking free today. However, we are talking about a deeper, spiritual freedom, a liberation of the soul that comes only from knowing Jesus.

Two Lineages: Truth vs. Lies

The knowledge you hold in your mind is incomplete if it is devoid of Christ. If you do not have Jesus, you are spiritually aligned with the wrong father. We must understand the spiritual lineage here: the devil is known as the father of all lies. *"Ye are of your father the devil... When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it."* (John 8:44)

Therefore, the devil is the Liar, whereas Jesus is the Truth. This creates a clear separation in humanity. Those who are in Christ Jesus are in the Truth. While those who are not in Christ do not possess the Truth, regardless of how "honest" they may appear in worldly matters. Their honesty is merely a human trait; but Jesus is a divine Power.

Conclusion

Truth and freedom come only from God. Satan cannot give truth, and he cannot give freedom—he is a liar and a slave master. Anything Satan offers may look attractive, but it always leads to bondage, confusion, and destruction.

If you are truly a child of Jesus Christ, then you have encountered the truth, because **God Himself is the Truth**. Truth is not an opinion, a philosophy, or human wisdom. Speaking “truth” according to the world cannot set you free. The world can expose problems, but it cannot deliver you.

Only Jesus sets free. As He said, *“You shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free”* (John 8:32). That truth is not information—it is a Person. Jesus Christ is the Truth, and freedom is found only in Him. Many people claim freedom while still living in sin. That is deception. Real freedom is not the ability to do anything you like; real freedom is the power to say no to sin. If sin still controls you, then you are not free, no matter what you claim.

Therefore, examine yourself. If Christ truly lives in you, truth will rule your life, and freedom will follow. But if you reject Christ, you will remain in bondage, no matter how loud you speak or how educated you are. There is no freedom outside Jesus Christ.

Personal Prayer

Heavenly Father, I come before You today acknowledging that my human understanding is limited, but Your wisdom is infinite. I thank You for revealing the ultimate Truth to me in the person of Your Son, Jesus Christ. Help me to not just speak honest words, but to live in the freedom that only comes from knowing Jesus. I declare that I am in Christ, and therefore, I will walk in the Truth. In the mighty name of Jesus, I pray. Amen.

FORGIVE AND FORGET: A CALL TO FREEDOM

Many people struggle to forgive, yet they find it even harder to forget. Every day, offenses come from those closest to us—whether it is your family member, your wife, your husband, your brother, your sister, or your parents. Some of you will say, "I will never forgive him or her," and you even swear an oath not to forgive. However, you must realize that unforgiveness is a sin against the Lord your God. Wherever you find yourself, you must learn how to forgive.

The Nature of Forgiveness

Forgiveness is the letting go of negative emotions and resentment toward someone who hurt you. You have to let go of that emotion because it is negative and not good for your life. No matter how badly they treated you or to what extent they went, if you can simply say, "I forgive you," a heavy burden will be lifted off your heart.

In **Matthew 6:12-13**, we read: "*And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.*"

Many of you recite the Lord's Prayer, but you have not been able to keep it. It is very simple: if you do not forgive, do not say the Lord's Prayer. It says, "forgive us our debts. When you forgive them, God will also forgive you."

Forgiveness and Boundaries

Remember, if you do not forgive others their trespasses, your Heavenly Father will not forgive you. If you still hold a grudge against anyone and pray, "Lord forgive me," He will not forgive you.

However, when you forgive, you can forgive and forget, but you must also apply wisdom. There are people you know who are very stubborn or toxic. When they wrong you, forgive them, but distance yourself from them. Use a "long spoon." Do not hate them, but do not be their close friend, because if you remain close friends, they will continue offending you.

What it Means to Forget Sometimes it is not easy to forget. When you see that person, you will naturally remember what happened. The kind of "forgetting" we are talking about is that you no longer hold the offense in your heart as a weapon.

Some of you behave like dogs; your hearts hold onto things tightly. When your enemy passes, you get angry and tell your neighbor, "That is the boy that slapped me the other day." In that way, there is no way you can forgive. To forgive, you must start to forget—meaning the malice is gone. Jesus forgave us on the cross, saying, "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing." That person who offended you may be ignorant of what they are doing, yet you are holding it in your heart.

Unforgiveness often stems from several core causes: malice, revenge, hatred, and anger. In some cases, it can also be the result of being possessed by an unforgiving spirit. You get rid of these sins.

Practical Steps to Forgiveness

Stop bearing grudges. Find a place in your heart to love someone. You must behave like a child to make heaven. When you beat a child, they cry, but if you buy them biscuits or chocolates, they follow you and forget the pain. That is how God wants you to be. You are not an adult in God's sight; only God is the adult.

Peter asked Jesus in **Matthew 18:21-22**, "*Lord, how many times do I have to forgive? Seven times?*" *Jesus answered, "No, not seven times, but seventy times seven, 70x7."* This shows forgiveness has no limit.

Consequences of Unforgiveness: Do not be deceived; there are consequences to holding grudges. Unforgiveness hinders your prayers and blocks your blessings. It positions you as an enemy of Christ, renders your own sins unforgivable, and gives demons access to use you.

How to Forgive Those Who Wronged You

Confront and Confess: Walk up to the person and say, "Victor, I forgive you for that thing you did." This teaches them forgiveness.

Be Merciful: Have pity on them, just as Jesus did.

Seek Professional Advice: Meet someone who can counsel you, and pray for the grace to forgive.

Assume Ignorance: Conclude they are ignorant of their actions. Look for excuses to forgive, not excuses to hold a grudge.

Continue Doing Good: If you normally greet them or give them tea, continue doing it. If you stop doing good, you cannot forgive. Buy them gifts; eventually, they will come to apologize.

Love Them: Love is the greatest commandment. With Agape love, you will be able to forgive.

Conclusion

Understand the serious spiritual consequences of holding a grudge. In the **Parable of the Unforgiving Servant** (Matthew 18:23–35), a man forgiven a massive debt by his Master refused to forgive a peer's trivial debt. Consequently, the Master delivered him to the tormentors. The principle is clear: **God's mercy is conditional upon your mercy toward others.**

Jesus further commanded in Matthew 5:23–24 that if you bring a gift to the altar and remember a grievance with your brother, you must leave your gift. Reconcile first, then offer your gift. God will not accept your worship if your heart is full of malice.

Therefore, forgive those debts and overlook those offenses. Withdraw that court case; drop that police case. Despite your deep pain, if you do not forgive, God will not forgive you. Practically, when lending money, **give only what you can afford to lose** so that bitterness does not take root. Do not allow unforgiveness to lead your soul to destruction.

Closing Prayer

"Lord, I come before You today with an open heart. I acknowledge that holding onto pain, bitterness, and old debts only weighs down my spirit and distances me from Your presence. Father, I choose this day to release every person who has hurt me. I let go of the anger, the memory of the offense, and the desire for revenge. Just as You freely forgave me when I did not deserve it, I extend that same mercy to others. Wash my heart clean of resentment so that nothing hinders my prayers or my blessings. In Jesus' name, Amen."

INDECENCY AT ITS PEAK

In our society today, indecent dressing has reached a fever pitch. Women wearing trousers, bikinis, skinny dresses, transparent dresses, short skirts, and skin-tight leggings have become the norm, creating a climax of rebellion where Satan uses fashion to destroy lives. You must realize that what you wear is the most important indicator of your spiritual standing. Indecency is not a "style"; it is the foundation of sexual immorality, lust, and prostitution.

In 2007, in my village, women wearing trousers or "bum shorts" were arrested and prosecuted by the Women's Wing. Today, those same groups have become the pioneers of nakedness, trading their dignity for rebellion. This is an evil that reeks in the nostrils of God. From young girls to the elderly, the contagion has spread. Historically, these garments were the exclusive uniform of the prostitute, yet today, every woman seems to be emulating the harlot. Women go into their rooms to "dress" but emerge naked, walking the streets in only panties and a polo shirt, or flaunting their breasts for public consumption. You cannot be a sanctuary of the Holy Spirit while dressed in the uniform of the marine kingdom.

THE HISTORY OF INDECENT DRESSING

The Calculated Deception: A History of the War on Modesty

Before now, women wore long skirts and gowns; they dared not wear trousers because it was highly restricted, not just by social custom but by government laws. In many nations, a woman caught in men's attire faced arrest for "impersonation" or "indecent." The current state of women's fashion is not an accident of history or a natural evolution of "style." It is the result of a deliberate, century-long campaign—marked by aggressive protests and legal lobbying—to dismantle the dignity of womanhood and replace it with a culture of public exposure.

The Masculinization of the Woman (The 1850s)

The assault began with the "Bloomer." In 1851, Elizabeth Smith Miller and Amelia Bloomer introduced trousers as a "practical" alternative to the dress.

Under the guise of health and gardening convenience, they launched a rebellion against the fundamental visual distinction between men and women.

While the public at the time—recorded in reports like those from *The Saturday Evening Post* (1858)—rightly identified this as a radical subversion of social order, the activists persisted. They used the "comfort" argument as a Trojan horse to enter the male domain. This was the first step in convincing women that to be "free," they had to look like men.

The Legal Rebellion: Arrests and Confrontations

The approval of trousers was forced upon the government through calculated civil disobedience. In 1919, labor activist Luisa Capetillo was arrested in Puerto Rico simply for wearing trousers in public. Her trial became a media circus used to challenge "indecent" laws. In the United States, women were arrested well into the 1930s for wearing slacks on the street.

The "approval" started in Western courts where activists argued that prohibiting trousers was a violation of "civil liberties." By the time the 1960s arrived, the government finally buckled. One of the final "approvals" happened in the U.S. Senate as late as 1993, when female senators led a "Pantsuit Rebellion," intentionally wearing trousers to the floor to force the government to strike down an unwritten ban that had stood for over 200 years.

The Commercialization of the "Male Gaze" (The 1920s)

Before the 1920s, a woman's worth was tied to her character and her role within the home. However, after World War I, the fashion industry—led by figures like Coco Chanel—began to market a new "ideal": the Flapper.

Hemlines rose to the knee, and for the first time in history, the "slender, boyish figure" was promoted over the mature, motherly form. The Fashion Institute of Technology (FIT) Archives note that this era introduced cosmetics (makeup) to the general public. Before this, makeup was almost exclusively used by "women of the night."

The industry shifted the focus from a woman's soul to her surface. They convinced women that they needed to decorate themselves and show their legs to be modern. You are being told that you are not enough as God made you; you must expose and decorate yourself to be "seen."

The Exposure of the Thigh: The Rise of Shorts (1930s)

The journey from trousers to shorts was a descent into increasing levels of nakedness. In 1933, Alice Marble broke social taboos by wearing shorts on the tennis court at Wimbledon. At the time, this was a scandal; today, it is seen as the moment the "kneecap" was conquered.

By the 1960s, designer Mary Quant—credited with the "Hot Pant"—pushed the boundaries even further. According to Vogue's historical archives, Quant's goal was to make clothes "arousing" and "daring." These were not garments designed for work or virtue; they were designed to draw the eye upward. The "bum short" was the final victory in making the public display of a woman's thighs a normal, daily occurrence.

The Bikini: The Atomic Bomb on Morality (1946)

Perhaps no garment has done more to destroy public decency than the bikini. In 1946, French engineer Louis Réard created a two-piece suit so small it was considered "indecent" by every professional model in Paris. He was forced to hire Micheline Bernardini, a woman who stripped for a living, to wear it.

The name itself is a confession of intent. Named after the **Bikini Atoll**—a site of nuclear testing—Réard explicitly stated he wanted the swimsuit to be "explosive." As noted in *Smithsonian Magazine's* history of the garment, the **bikini** was intended to shatter the remaining foundations of modesty. Society's acceptance of the bikini marked the moment that the world officially chose "lust of the eyes" over the protection of the family unit.

The Modern Cult of Exposure (1964 – Present)

In 1964, the agenda reached its peak with Rudi Gernreich, the designer who introduced the "Monokini" (topless swimsuit). While the world gasped, the fashion industry cheered. According to reports in *The New York Times* (1964), Gernreich argued that the female body should have no "shame."

This "no shame" philosophy is the foundation of every low-cut top and breast-revealing garment seen today. It demands that women treat their bodies as public property rather than a private sanctuary. By gradually lowering necklines and shrinking hemlines, the industry has trained women to believe that their value is tied to how much of their skin is visible to strangers.

The Invention of "Sheer" and the "Naked" Look (The 1990s - Present)

In the last 30 years, the industry has stopped inventing new clothes and started simply removing the fabric. This is the era of "sheer" clothing and "skin-tight" spandex.

Designers like Jean Paul Gaultier and Gianni Versace popularized the "naked dress"—garments that use transparent mesh or are so tight they reveal every intimate curve. The Metropolitan Museum of Art (Costume Institute) describes the 90s as the "Era of Hyper-sexuality."

This is the final stage of the agenda. The industry no longer asks you to show your skin; they ask you to show your shape as if you were naked. When you wear leggings that leave nothing to the imagination, you are participating in a trend started by people who view the female body as a commodity for sale.

Note of Life: The Reality of the "Fashion" Trap

You must understand that every major shift in the history of women's dress was sold under a false pretense to make the poison easier to swallow. It began with *The Bloomer*, which was marketed under the lie that it was "for health," but the real result was the strategic erasing of the God-given line between the male and the female. Following this, *The Short* was introduced under the guise of sports and athletic performance; however, its true purpose was to normalize the public exposure of the thigh, a part of the body meant to be covered.

The deception continued with *The Bikini*, promoted as a practical necessity for the sun, yet functioning as the primary tool for making public nakedness a standard. Finally, we arrived at the era of *Low-cut and Sheer Tops*, which the industry claims are "for beauty." In reality, these garments serve only one purpose: to invite the predatory gaze of the world and turn a woman's dignity into a public spectacle. The "reason" is a mask, but the "result" is your spiritual and social exposure.

History proves that the world did not "give" women these clothes; it sold them a lie. You were told that showing more skin is "power," yet this power only serves to turn you into an object for public consumption.

The question is no longer "what is in style," but *whose agenda are you wearing?* If your clothing follows a timeline started by nude dancers and radical rebels, you are not expressing yourself, you are being used as a billboard for a movement that hates the idea of modesty.

The Source of the "Modern" Look: When these styles first appeared, they were not found on the "virtuous woman." They were the exclusive domain of:

Prostitutes: Who originated high hemlines, heavy theatrical makeup, and sheer fabrics to signal sexual availability and attract customers.

Nude Dancers: Who were the only women willing to wear the first bikinis and "naked" designs when respectable models refused the "indecenty."

Rebellious Celebrities: Who used these shocking styles as a marketing tool to gain fame, breaking government laws and social taboos.

The fashion industry has successfully "laundered" the clothing of the brothel and the stage, renaming it "high fashion" to sell it to the average woman. What was once the mark of a "woman of the night" is now marketed as the standard of a "modern woman." By adopting these trends, you are not exercising freedom; you are unknowingly adopting the uniform of a rebellion designed to destroy shame.

SALVATION AND THE TRAP OF THE GARDEN

Now that you have understood the calculated history of the "Fashion Trap," we must dive into the real message of salvation. The Bible provides a clear, unyielding boundary in **Deuteronomy 22:5**:

“The woman shall not wear that which pertaineth unto a man, neither shall a man put on a woman’s garment: for all that do so are abomination unto the LORD thy God.”

Many modern voices argue that this only means you shouldn't wear a shirt that a man has already worn—but does that make sense? Others argue that "men's trousers" and "women's trousers" are different. This is a deception. God's law is not about the zipper or the label; it is about the fundamental distinction between the sexes. To cross that line is to become an abomination in the sight of the Creator.

The Garden of Eden: The Original Covering

To understand the root of the war on modesty, we must go back to the beginning. After Adam and Eve sinned, they discovered they were naked (**Genesis 3:7**). Who made them discover their nakedness? It was Satan, working through the serpent. God, in His mercy, did not leave them in their shame; He clothed them with coats of skins. However, after God had clothed them, Satan returned with a new lie. He moved into the minds of men and women to suggest that they uncover what God had covered. Satan says, "Uncover your body so men can see you; you were originally created naked, so go naked." Just as he gave them forbidden fruit to eat, he has now given them forbidden garments to wear. This is the primary reason many women are heading to hell today.

The Punishment from God

Indecency is the mother of immorality, and God will not hold you guiltless if your appearance leads another into sin. When you wear these things, regardless of your "purpose," you are participating in sin. When men see you and lust, you become a partner in their fall.

Jesus gave a terrifying warning in **Matthew 18:6-7**: *"If anyone causes one of these little ones... to stumble, it would be better for them to have a large millstone hung around their neck and to be drowned in the depths of the sea... woe to the person through whom they come!"*

Furthermore, in **Isaiah 3:16-24**, God condemns the women of Zion for their seductive behavior and obsession with outward beauty. Because they flaunted their appearance to attract the "gaze of the world," God declared a judgment of shame. He promised that their fragrance would turn to stench, their fine clothes to sackcloth, and their beauty to disgrace.

Who Deceived You?

Consider this: if a man should walk down the street in a tight bikini, bum shorts, leggings, or a skirt, what would you think of him? You would call him a madman, a homosexual, or a fool. You would laugh at him, refuse to marry him, and no employer would hire him. Why then do you think you can wear what "pertaineth to a man" while a man cannot wear what is yours?

The devil is cunning. He has convinced you that you look "sexy" in the very garments that would make a man look insane.

When you see your own level of exposure on others, you might feel disgusted, yet you feel comfortable when it is on your own body.

We must be honest: when you wear these revealing clothes, the spiritual world and the discerning eye see you as a seducer, a marine agent, and a daughter of rebellion. You are wearing the uniform of a prostitute while claiming to be a child of God.

EMULATION AND PEER PRESSURE

Most women and girls today fell into the trap of indecency through the subtle poison of peer pressure and emulation. They began by copying friends, not realizing they were stepping onto a path of destruction. These garments were once the exclusive uniform of prostitutes, strippers, and worldly celebrities, but today, the line has been erased. Satan has achieved his greatest goal: you can no longer differentiate between a woman of God and a harlot. The Bible warns us: *"And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind"* (**Romans 12:2**).

THE ROLE OF PASTORS, PRIESTS, AND FALSE PROPHETS

Many pastors today are the chief architects of this deception, allowing women to enter the sanctuary in trousers, bikinis, and revealing garments. They hide behind the lie that "God only looks at the heart" or that people should "come as they are." The truth is that such a leader is either deceived, a fake, or a direct agent of darkness. Look closely at these social gatherings called churches; you will find that these pastors often have skeletons in their cupboards, with hidden records of rape, sexual affairs, and worldly living. You are proud to call him "Pastor," but the reality is that you are both heading to hell. When women in filthy attire climb the altar to sing or preach, it is a peak abomination that invites the judgment of God upon the house. Below are few deceptions by false teachers:

(A). The Deception of "Come as You Are": When pastors use "Come as you are" to justify wearing the clothing of the prostitute or the rebel in the sanctuary, they forget the parable of the Wedding Garment (**Matthew 22:11-13**). In that history, a man was invited to the feast, but when he refused to put on the appropriate garment provided by the King and insisted on staying "as he was," he was cast out.

"Come as you are" is the invitation to the altar, but "Holiness" is the requirement for the walk. You cannot claim to be a new creature while intentionally wearing the uniform of the old world.

(B). The Deception of "God Does Not Look at the Outward Appearance": Many modern believers use the phrase "God looks at the heart" as a shield to protect their worldly fashion choices. They claim that because God accepted David and Jesus despite their appearance, He is indifferent to the "bum shorts" and "bikinis" worn today. This is a dangerous misinterpretation.

When the Prophet Samuel went to anoint a king, he was overwhelmed by the physical power of Eliab, and God spoke to him: *"Look not on his countenance, or on the height of his stature... for man looketh on the outward appearance, but the Lord looketh on the heart"* (1 Samuel 16:7). Samuel was looking at biology. He thought a King must be a giant. God was saying that David's small physical frame did not disqualify him because his heart was right. To use this passage to justify wearing clothes designed by prostitutes is to lie against the Word of God.

In John 7:24, Jesus commands: *"Judge not according to the appearance, but judge righteous judgment."* Jesus was rebuking the religious leaders who judged Him for healing on the Sabbath and for his humble background. He was **NOT** rebuking people for having a standard of modesty. If you use Jesus' words to justify wearing garments invented by nude dancers, you are using the Word of God to defend the work of the devil. God does not judge you for your height.

(C). The Great Lie: The Deception of "Western Tradition" It is a capital lie when modern pastors claim that indecent dressing is simply the "tradition of the Western world." This is not a matter of culture, but a history of successful rebellion. Up until the 1930s, Western governments actively banned women from wearing trousers. The rampant nakedness we see today is not a "tradition"—it is a broken boundary.

There is a simple "eye-test" for the clothes you wear: if your garment causes someone's eyes to land on your buttocks, chest, or laps the moment they see you, it is indecent. Modesty dictates that when someone sets eyes on you, the first place they should look is your face. Any clothing that bypasses your face to highlight your "sides" or curves has turned you into an object for public consumption.

(D). The Deception: "God Will Not Send All These Women to Hell"

There is a poisonous doctrine being spread by a top pastor in Nigeria who claimed that God is "too merciful" to send such a vast number of women to hell simply because they chose to wear trousers or bum shorts.

When I heard this, I laughed at the absurdity. Such a statement is not an act of love; it is a disgrace to the Kingdom of God. This pastor is offering a "group discount" on sin, but God judges individuals according to His Word.

The Bible declares in Romans 1:20 that men are "without excuse." It is a binary reality: you either belong to Heaven or you belong to Hell. There is no middle ground for the "fashionably rebellious." Do not hide behind the phrase "God is merciful" to justify your nakedness. Mercy is for the person who repents, not for the person who uses it as a license to remain a "daughter of Jezebel." Remember the days of Noah: the majority stayed outside the ark, and the majority perished.

THE MARRIAGE TRAP: THE QUEST FOR A HUSBAND

Many single women today fall into the trap of dressing half-naked under the delusion that they must look "hot" to secure a husband. You must understand that the bait you use determines the fish you catch. When you dress in filthy, revealing garments, you are not attracting a life partner; you are inviting predators who only seek to use you and dump you.

Satan is a cruel master; he will give you the husband you sought through immodesty only to punish you through him. God will not give a virtuous man to a woman who refuses to cover herself. By dressing like the "image of a prostitute" or a marine spirit, you signal that you belong to the world, attracting only street boys, criminals, "yahoo boys," and occultic men. If you truly desire a God-fearing man, you must first be God-fearing yourself.

THE ROOT OF THE ROT: PARENTAL DECEIT

The epidemic of immodesty is a direct result of the failure of the home. Women of this generation have become recruiters for the kingdom of darkness by training their own daughters to wear filthy garments. When you dress your female children in "bum shorts," trousers, and bikinis, you are searing their consciences. You are teaching them that their value lies in the exposure of their skin. God will hold you responsible if anything happens to that child.

You have ignored the command: *"Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it"* (Proverbs 22:6). Because you trained them in the way of the world, they have departed from the way of God.

This is why some are raped or engage in immorality even while in school—because young boys lust after them, focusing on the shape of their bodies. Even husbands who encourage their wives to dress "hot" for the public have lost their headship and become pimps for their own households.

THE INSTITUTIONALIZED SIN: SCHOOLS AND WORKPLACES

The war on modesty has moved from a personal choice to an institutional mandate. Today, schools and workplaces actively force women into the "Fashion Trap" under the guise of sports or professionalism. In many schools, female children are mandated to wear shorts for sports. These institutions are no longer teaching children how to live; they are teaching them how to perish.

In Nigeria, the NYSC camps have become a theater of shame. Beyond the mandatory trousers, female corps members are often forced to wear very short, thin, white shorts for social nights. We must celebrate the Christian youths who stood their ground, refusing these garments even at the cost of their certificates. In the corporate world, employers often bypass the modest woman in favor of those willing to wear "skin-tight" trousers or low-cut tops. When a workplace demands you "use what you have to get what you want," they are offering you a seat in a brothel, not a career.

THE DEMONIC EXCHANGE: FASHION AS A PORTAL

Behind the curtains of the fashion industry, there is a dark spiritual reality. Malevolent spirits—male demons—constantly watch for an opening. When you put on those revealing garments, you issue an invitation to the kingdom of darkness. Indecency is the legal ground upon which demons enter a woman's life.

Most of these "modern" fashion trends are not born in design studios; they are birthed in the marine kingdom. Shockingly, even some pastors are part of this darkness, mandated to tell you that "God doesn't care about your clothes."

" For many women, marriage crises, family issues, and sudden sicknesses trace back to a wardrobe that invited a spirit of lust. To you, you look "beautiful," but before God you are filthy.

THE WITNESS OF REALITY

The truth of this message is confirmed daily. I recently had to disembark from a public transport vehicle because a nursing mother sitting in front of me was wearing trousers that pulled down so far they exposed her buttocks. Even mothers, who should be guardians of dignity, are now comfortable with public exposure.

During evangelism in Lagos, several women admitted they knew their dressing was sinful but insisted they would continue wearing it. This reveals a terrifying truth: at least 80% of those dressing indecently are not doing so out of ignorance. They have made a conscious decision to perish.

The Marine Connection and the Falling Pulpit During deliverance sessions, many possessed by marine spirits have confessed that these attires—bikinis, leggings, bum shorts—are spiritual tools used to possess women. Even the sanctuary is not safe. I once visited a church only to catch the pastor in a compromising position with a lady dressed in bum shorts. When the leader is comfortable with such indecency in the house of God, the entire congregation is being led to the gates of Hell.

The Tragedy of the "Good" Woman A pastor once shared a story of a young lady who had been very kind to him. After she died, the pastor prayed, "God, please do not let this lady go to hell; she was so good." Immediately, the pastor was taken into a vision where he saw this same lady in Hell. The angel told him: *"She is here because she dressed indecently. No matter her kindness, she cannot enter Heaven in the uniform of rebellion."* Do not be "too busy" to hear this truth. Your kindness and tithes will not cancel out the sin of public nakedness.

THE VANITY OF EXCUSES: TEARING DOWN THE LIES

Many women invent excuses to justify their rebellion, but God is not mocked.

"My trousers are loose or corporate": Whether they are loose or corporate, they are garments pertaining to a man. An abomination does not become holy because it is expensive or tailored.

"I wear a long top or jacket over the trousers to cover my shape": This is the spirit of religion—trying to sanitize a sin.

Partial obedience is total disobedience. Covering your buttocks while still wearing a garment that "pertaineth to a man" is like painting a coffin white; the outside looks clean, but the inside is full of dead man's bones. You cannot cover an abomination; you must remove it.

"Wearing a gown doesn't mean you are holy": While a gown doesn't automatically save you, public nakedness certainly condemns you.

"My pastor says it's not a sin": Your pastor is not the judge of the universe. If he leads you into fire, you will both burn.

"My husband mandates me to wear it": You must obey God rather than men. If you cannot convince him, take it to the throne of God in prayer.

"It is the uniform of my school or workplace": The Bible says if your eye causes you to sin, pluck it out (**Matthew 5:29**). No salary is worth your soul.

"In the olden days, people dressed half-naked": Yes, and that is why they were in darkness! Jesus came to bring light and dignity.

"I don't feel comfortable in gowns": You don't feel comfortable because Satan has seared your conscience. The "freedom" you feel in trousers is the freedom of a sheep walking into the slaughterhouse.

"It's just fashion, it's not that deep": Every physical thing has a spiritual root. If it isn't deep, why are you so desperate to wear it?

"I am dressing for myself, not for men": This is a capital lie. If you were alone on an island, you would not wear bikinis. You dress for the "gaze." You have opened doors for temptations and sin and have been captured by Satan; you have no choice.

"God knows my heart": Yes, He knows your heart is full of rebellion, which is why it manifests on your body. A pure heart cannot produce a harlot's appearance.

"Who are you to judge me?": It is our duty to correct you to save your soul. To remain silent while you dress your way to Hell is not love; it is hatred.

"Deuteronomy 22 vs 5 is Old Testament": Do not be deceived by those who say Deuteronomy 22:5 is only for the Old Testament. God's hatred for abomination does not change with time; if it was an abomination then, it is an abomination now.

The Apostles confirmed this for the New Testament Church in **1 Timothy 2:9-10**, commanding women to "adorn themselves in modest apparel, with shamefacedness and sobriety... which becometh women professing godliness." Grace is not a license to dress like a harlot; it is the power to live holy.

"I wear it to exercise or at the gym": There is no "gym exception" in the Bible. You cannot expose your nakedness under the guise of fitness. Your spiritual fitness is more important than your physical shape. *"For bodily exercise profiteth little: but godliness is profitable unto all things"* (**1 Timothy 4:8**).

"I am pregnant and trousers are more comfortable/supportive": Pregnancy is a gift from God; do not use His blessing as a license to insult Him. Did Mary wear trousers when she carried Jesus? There are loose, comfortable maternity gowns that offer dignity. To wear trousers while carrying a child is to introduce that unborn baby to the spirit of rebellion before they are even born.

"It makes me look smart and hot": Do not worry about being "hot" now. Hellfire is already hot and waiting for the unrepentant. If you insist on being "hot" through indecency, you will get into Hell and become hotter forever.

"The weather is hot; I need ventilation": This is a pure lie. Gowns and wrappers provide far more ventilation than tight trousers and bikinis that cling to your skin. The devil has made your mind "hot" so that you can get used to the heat of Hell. If you complain about the sun, how will you survive the fire and sulfur where there is no water for eternity? Men face the same sun and do not go naked; your ancestors lived in heat and remained covered.

"I wear trousers because of the Cold/Harmattan": If our mothers and grandmothers survived the cold and Harmattan with wrappers and long slips, you have no excuse. You can wear thick tights or warmers under your long skirt to stay warm. But to wear trousers outwardly because of the weather is to fear the cold more than you fear God. Remember, the outer darkness of Hell is colder than any winter, and the Lake of Fire is hotter than any summer.

"It is the new fashion; not wearing it makes me archaic and not smart": Do you prefer to look "smart" for the world and look like a fool before God?

The "fashion" of this world is passing away. It is better to be called archaic on earth and be celebrated in Heaven than to be "trendy" and end up in the lake of fire.

"Trousers help me move freely to climb, run, or board bikes": This is a deception. Our mothers and grandmothers did all these things in gowns and wrappers with dignity. You don't need to dress like a man to be "free." True freedom is found in the Spirit, not in wearing a man's garment. *"Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free" (Galatians 5:1)*—not the "liberty" to wear trousers.

"Trousers protect me from rape/sexual harassment better than skirts": This is a lie from the pit of Hell. Your protection is the Blood of Jesus, not a piece of denim or jean material. Rape is caused by a demonic spirit of lust. By wearing the "uniform of rebellion," you actually remove the hedge of divine protection and invite the very attacks you claim to fear. A daughter of Zion is protected by her holiness, not her pants.

"It's my body and my choice; I am not the one sinning, men should control themselves": This is the lie of a capital liar. You are your brother's keeper. If you dress to provoke lust, you are a primary participant in that sin. The Bible is clear: *"But whoso shall offend one of these little ones which believe in me, it were better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and that he were drowned in the depth of the sea" (Matthew 18:6)*.

"I don't care if they look, that's their problem": It becomes your problem when you stand before the Great White Throne. Jesus said: *"But I say unto you, That whosoever looketh on a woman to lust after her hath committed adultery with her already in his heart" (Matthew 5:28)*. By dressing indecently, you are an accessory to adultery. You are a "walking temptation," and whether you care or not, you are going to Hell for promoting the spirit of lust.

"It is not men's clothing; it is made for women": Haha! Satan is at it again with his clever labels. Did you not read the *History and Origin* in the previous chapters? Just because a tailor puts a "female" label on an abomination does not change its nature in the sight of God. This is a demonic trick to bypass your conscience. If a man should wear a so-called "male bikini" or a woman's gown, would you not immediately call him a madman or a pervert? Why then do you think you can wear his garments and remain holy? This belief is a spiritual delusion designed to blur the lines between the sexes.

The Bible says, *"The woman shall not wear that which pertaineth unto a man"* (**Deuteronomy 22:5**). It does not say "unless a designer makes it for her." If it is a bifurcated garment (trousers), it pertaineth to the man. By putting them on, you are inviting a spirit of perversion and gender confusion into your life.

You are dressing in the "uniform of rebellion." Whether it was sewn for a woman or not, it remains a tool of the devil to strip you of your feminine dignity and your place in the Kingdom of God.

"If I do not wear it, I won't get a job in that company": You do not need any job that will serve as a visa to Hell. Why would you trade your eternal soul for a monthly salary? If a company rejects you because you refuse to dress in filthy garments or put on the "uniform of rebellion," let them keep their job. God is the one who opens doors that no man can shut. *"For what shall it profit a man, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul?"* (**Mark 8:36**). There are hundreds of companies and businesses looking for decent, God-fearing women of integrity, but you haven't seen them yet because you are still blinded by Satan's delusion. Clear your eyes! Make up your mind to serve God first, and He will provide a better job—one that fits your godly lifestyle and honors your Creator. *"But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you"* (**Matthew 6:33**).

"But the cloth looks good, I don't see anything wrong with it": Hmm, so you have now become the judge of what is holy? You do not determine what sin is; God does. Your eyes are carnal, and they are deceiving you. What you call "looking good," God calls an abomination. What you see as "fashion," God sees as a garment of fire. You say your conscience is clear, but a clear conscience is not a certificate of innocence. If you are in violation of God's Word, your feelings cannot save you. The Apostle Paul made it clear that even if he felt he was doing right, it didn't mean he was innocent before God: *"My conscience is clear, but that does not make me innocent. It is the Lord who judges me"* (**1 Corinthians 4:4**). If you continue to follow what "looks good" to your eyes instead of what is written in the Word, you are making yourself a god. Humble yourself, or you will weep in the darkness of Hell. *"There is a way which seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death"* (**Proverbs 14:12**).

"Everybody is wearing it, does it mean they will go to hell?": Yes! They will go to Hell. Since when did "everybody" become the standard for righteousness? If everyone chooses to jump into a lake of fire, will you join them just to fit in? The majority is almost always wrong in the sight of God.

Even if your mother, your sisters, or your best friends wear these abominable garments, do you love them enough to burn with them for eternity?

"Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide is the gate, and broad is the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat: Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it." (Matthew 7:13-14).

Do not be comforted by the crowd. The "everyone" you are following today will be the same "everyone" wailing and gnashing their teeth tomorrow. If you follow the multitude to dress like a harlot, you will follow the multitude into the pit. Standing alone for God is better than falling with the world.

Do you still have more excuses? Perhaps, because Satan is very cunning, he may raise thoughts and ask you to ignore this message. But if you have seen the light and are ready to change, congratulations.

ARE YOU STILL CLAIMING TO BE A VIRTUOUS WOMAN?

A Virtuous Woman is a woman of moral excellence, strength, and godliness. She is a woman who fears the Lord and whose value is far above rubies (**Proverbs 31:10**). If you dress indecently, you can never be a virtuous woman. You may have the beauty, the money, and the fame, but without modesty, you are a "fair woman without discretion"—like a gold ring in a pig's snout.

Mary is the ultimate example of a virtuous woman. She was found worthy because she lived a life of purity and dressed with the dignity of a daughter of Zion. This was one of the reasons God chose her to bear the Savior, Jesus Christ. Looking at your wardrobe today, will God ever think of using you? Can the Holy Spirit dwell in a temple that is constantly on display for the world?

In this generation, when a woman dresses in nice, modest female gowns and skirts, she is mocked and called "archaic" or "old-fashioned." This generation wants to enjoy the pleasures of the world and still make heaven—that is impossible. You cannot follow the trends of the devil and expect the reward of the righteous. You must choose: the applause of the world or the approval of God.

THE TRAP OF "GENDER EQUALITY"

Modern "Gender Equality" is nothing more than a rebellion against the creative order of God. Women love these filthy garments because, in their hearts, they want to look like men and exercise the authority given to men.

This is the same spirit that possessed Eve in the Garden—she wanted to be wiser than God, and her pursuit of that "equality" attracted a curse that nearly destroyed humanity.

Everyone has a divine place in life. When women refuse to stay in the place God carved out for them, chaos follows. This "equality" movement is the root cause of the abominations we see today:

The Spirit of Confusion: Women transitioning to be men and men mutilating themselves to become women.

The Death of the Family: The opposite sex marrying each other in defiance of nature and God's Word.

Thank God that some nations have seen the madness and rejected these trends. If they were fully approved globally, many of you would adopt these perversions within a few years and pass them unto your children as a "norm." You would raise a generation to defend rubbish and call it progress.

God will judge everyone by the same standard. There is no amount of "human rights" or social excuses that can justify sin. God will not change His mind about a sin because you have a useless opinion.

"For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, saith the Lord. For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts." (Isaiah 55:8-9)

Remember, the road that leads to Heaven is narrow. You must stand firm against any conviction—be it for business, pleasure, or sports—that seeks to put you in a man's garment. Reject them entirely. Your opinion does not matter in the courtroom of the Almighty; only His Word remains forever.

EXTRA: INGREDIENTS OF INDECENCY – BEAUTIFUL FOR SATAN

You may cover your nakedness and still be indecent in the sight of God. Satan is a master strategist; he knows that if you only wear a bikini or trousers, many will castigate you. So, he introduced "**artificial ingredients**" to finish the work. He wants to mask your God-given beauty and turn you into something that looks like an Italian fish or a crayfish.

These are the **Ingredients of Jezebel**, and they are purely **Marine**:

Face & Eyes: Makeups, lipsticks, eyelashes, and colored eye contacts.

Jewelry: Earrings, nose rings, and necklaces.

Hair & Hands: Attachments, wigs, artificial nails, and the painting of nails.

These items are not "beauty products"; they are demonic tools. In the past, people watched movies like *Karashika* to see demons, but today, women have become *Karashika* themselves! You have transformed your face and body into a billboard for the marine kingdom.

THE CONSEQUENCE OF DEMONIC ADORNMENT

Do not be surprised why so many women are demon-possessed today. When you wear items from the pit of hell, you give legal ground for demons to gain access to your life. You are literally wearing the "uniform" of the kingdom of darkness.

If you are covered in these items, you are not beautiful; you are spiritually filthy. You must strip yourself of these Jezebelian ornaments if you want to be delivered and used by God.

The message is clear: The way you dress is the way you will be addressed. Indecency is the foundation of sexual immorality. There are no more excuses. Every institution on earth has a uniform; why do you think the Kingdom of Heaven is different? By choosing to dress indecently, You defile the Temple of the Holy Spirit, You invite danger, rape, and sexual harassment, You become an adversary of God, You promote the marine agenda, You bear the mark of the harlot.

The Moment of Decision

The choice is yours. Will you cling to your "filthy garments" and perish, or will you repent today? Do not give these clothes to others or sell them. Gather them—the trousers, leggings, bum shorts, and revealing tops—and set them ablaze. Surrender completely to Jesus today.

I wash my soul in the Blood of Jesus Christ. Forgive me, Lord. I burn these garments today as a sign that I am finished with the world. I choose Heaven over the trends of the earth. In Jesus' Name, Amen."
